A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE UPDATED THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM SURTAX INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT (ILA) BETWEEN THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH AND BROWARD COUNTY TO PROVIDE SURTAX FUNDING FOR THE CITY HALL-004 SIDEWALK ADA IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (BC-HBEACH-FY2020-00001), CONSTRUCTION PHASE, WHICH PROJECT ALLOCATES TWO MILLION, SEVEN HUNDRED, THIRTEEN THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED, FIFTY-NINE DOLLARS AND SIX CENTS (\$2,713,559.06) IN SURTAX FUNDING TO THE CITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE OF THE PROJECT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Section 23-9, Award, (e), the City Manager may award procurements within the delegated spending authority, and all other procurements, except emergency procurements, require commission approval for award; and

WHEREAS, the Hall-004 Sidewalk ADA Improvements Project, Construction Phase, has been determined to be statutorily eligible for funding and has received approval for funding from the Broward County Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, The City Hall-004 Sidewalk ADA Improvements Project, Construction Phase, is included in the City's Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP); and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2025, the City Commission approved Resolution No. 2025-079, authorizing the execution of the Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the City and Broward County to provide surtax funding for the City Hall-004 Sidewalk ADA Improvements Project (BC-HBEACH-FY2020-00001), Construction Phase; and

36 **WHEREAS**, the purpose of the ILA is to outline the terms and conditions under which
37 the County will provide transportation surtax funding for the project, and under which the City
38 will complete the project; and

39 **WHEREAS**, after the City submitted the executed version to MAP Broward for County
40 execution, the County requested that the City enter into an updated Third Amendment to the
41 Transportation System Project-Specific Municipal Interlocal Agreement for surtax funding
42 related to the City Hall-004 Sidewalk ADA Improvements Project, Construction Phase, since
43 the Third Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement had become effective, which included new
44 processes and documentation, requiring the City to place the updated agreement on the
45 Commission agenda for approval before it could be executed by the County; and

46 **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to be in the
47 public interest to authorize execution of the updated Third Amendment to the Transportation
48 System Surtax Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the City and Broward County to provide
49 Surtax funding for the City Hall-004 Sidewalk ADA Improvements Project (BC-HBEACH-
50 FY2020-00001), Construction Phase, which project allocates Two Million, Seven Hundred,
51 Thirteen Thousand, Five Hundred, Fifty-Nine Dollars and Six Cents (\$2,713,559.06) in surtax
52 funding to the City of Hallandale Beach for the construction phase of the project, and to
53 authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

58 **SECTION 1. Whereas Clauses.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated

61 **SECTION 2. Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize
62 execution of the updated Third Amendment to the Transportation System Surtax Interlocal
63 Agreement (ILA) between the City and Broward County to provide Surtax funding for the City
64 Hall-004 Sidewalk ADA Improvements Project (BC-HBEACH-FY2020-00001), Construction
65 Phase, which project allocates Two Million, Seven Hundred, Thirteen Thousand, Five
66 Hundred, Fifty-Nine Dollars and Six Cents (\$2,713,559.06) in surtax funding to the City of

Hallandale Beach for the construction phase of the project, and to authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

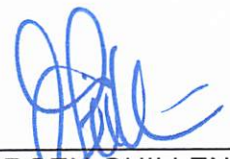
SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.

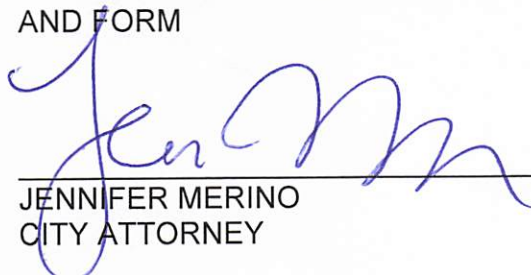
