

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH AND BLUE LINE SOLUTIONS, LLC. FOR IMPLEMENTATION FOR A SPEED CAMERA ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM IN SCHOOL ZONES**

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made and entered into upon the date of final execution by the parties, by and between the City of Hallandale Beach, a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, located at 400 S. Federal Highway, Hallandale Beach, Florida, 33009, hereinafter referred to as CITY, and Blue Line Solutions, LLC, a limited liability company authorized to do business in the state of Florida, located at 4409 Oakwood Drive, Chattanooga, TN, 37416, hereinafter referred to as CONTRACTOR (the "Agreement").

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Section 23-5 Competitive procurement required; Procurement Mechanisms, Subsection (4) Piggybacking, the City may procure goods or services from vendors who have been selected as a result of a competitive selection process by another governmental entity if the selection process utilized by the contracting entity was substantially similar to the requirements of the City, and the goods or services procured by the City are procured pursuant to the original contract scope and terms; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Legislature enacted certain provisions of state law governing the use of automated Speed Detection Systems ("SDS") in School Zones, which was codified in Sections 316.003, 316.008, and 316.0776, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has implemented an automated SDS program in school zones in order to reduce speeding and benefit public safety; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 9, 2025, the Town of Pembroke Park and Blue Line Solutions, LLC entered into an agreement for Creation and Implementation for a Speed Camera Enforcement Program in School Zones Only following RFP. No. 12 473-14 (the "Source Agreement"); and

**WHEREAS**, CITY and CONTRACTOR wish to enter into an agreement utilizing the Source Agreement to comply with Sec. 316.1896(5)(b), Fla. Stat.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged by the parties, City and Provider covenant and agree as follows:

1. **Whereas Clauses.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated herein.
2. CONTRACTOR agrees to install, operate the equipment, operate the system, manage the program, issue notices of violation, maintain data, collect fines, distribute funds, and report data pursuant to the terms of the Source Agreement and strictly in accordance with the requirements of Florida Statutes, as may be amended.
3. **Insurance.** CONTRACTOR shall provide insurance in the types and amounts set forth in the Source Agreement and provide a Certificate of Insurance naming the City of Hallandale Beach in lieu of current Art. 7 of the Source Agreement.
4. **Notices.** The Notice Address in the Source Agreement for City in Art. 10.2 shall be replaced with:

5. **Sovereign Immunity.** The parties agree to add Art. 14, Sovereign Immunity, to the Source Agreement, which provides: Nothing in this Agreement is intended to serve as a waiver of sovereign immunity, or of any other immunity, defense, or privilege enjoyed by the CITY pursuant to Section 768.28 Florida Statutes.
6. Public Records.

7. **Priority of Agreement.** Except as set forth herein, the parties agree that all terms and conditions applicable to CONTRACTOR as set forth in the Source Agreement, including its exhibits, amendments and addendums, shall be applicable to this Agreement with the CITY, and in the event of conflict this Agreement shall govern.

8. **Representation.** All parties to this Agreement certify that the representatives named herein, and executing hereunder, possess full and complete authority to bind said parties.

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**RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 014**

**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF  
THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,  
AUTHORIZING UTILIZATION OF THE TOWN OF PEMBROKE  
PARK CONTRACT WITH BLUE LINE SOLUTIONS, LLC TO  
PURCHASE HALLANDALE BEACH SCHOOL ZONE SPEED  
CAMERA ENFORCEMENT AND COLLECTION SERVICES;  
AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-5, Competitive Procurement Required, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services in excess of the delegated spending authority, shall be based on a competitive procurement process, and pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 26-9 (e), while the City Manager may award procurements within the delegated spending authority, all other procurements, except emergency procurements, require commission approval for award; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Section 23-5 Competitive procurement required; Procurement Mechanisms, Subsection (4) Piggybacking, the City may procure goods or services from vendors who have been selected as a result of a competitive selection process by another governmental entity if the selection process utilized by the contracting entity was substantially similar to the requirements of the City, and the goods or services procured by the City are procured pursuant to the original contract scope and terms; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach solicited contracts pursuant to RFP No. FY 2024-2025-07, Speed Detection Camera System for School Zones, but was unable to complete negotiations with the first ranked firm, Jenoptik Smart Mobility Solutions, LLC, and with the second ranked firm, and Blue Line Solutions, LLC; and

**WHEREAS**, in July of 2025, the Town of Pembroke Park awarded Town of Pembroke Park RFP No. 12-473-14 contract to the above identified second ranked firm, Blue Line Solutions, LLC, for similar speed detection camera services that closely align with the terms sought by the City through its RFP (the "Source Agreement"); and

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**WHEREAS**, consistent with Sec. 316.1896(5)(b), Fla. Stat. and the Source Agreement, the Contractor performs collection activities for each \$100 ticket, retains its \$15 per ticket as its contractor fee, pays the City its \$45 per ticket (that must be used to administer speed detection systems in school zones and other public safety initiatives pursuant to Sec. 316.1896(5)(b), F.S.), and transfers the balance collected per ticket to the City, after which the City will forward from the balance transferred to it the following amounts required to be transmitted to other agencies in accordance with the Source Agreement and applicable law: a) \$20 State General Revenue Fund, b) \$12 local school district, c) \$3 DLE Criminal Justice Standards and Training Trust Fund and d) \$5 retained by county or city for the School Crossing Guard Recruitment and Retention Program; and

**WHEREAS**, in exchange for the \$15 retained by Contractor for each ticket, Contractor is responsible for all costs and services associated with the installation of the required infrastructure, including equipment, cameras, and permits at all City locations, and will manage the majority of the speed enforcement program including, without limitation, the initiation of citations, mailing of required notices, and all collection activities.

**WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to be in the public interest to authorize utilization of the Town of Pembroke Park RFP No. 12-473-14 contract with Blue Line Solutions, LLC to purchase Hallandale Beach school zone speed camera enforcement and collection services, and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1. Whereas Clauses.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2. Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize utilization of the Town of Pembroke Park RFP No. 12-473-14 contract with Blue Line Solutions, LLC to purchase Hallandale Beach school zone speed camera enforcement and collection services, and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.


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
**SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
