ORDINANCE NO. 2026 -

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY  
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH,  
FLORIDA, AMENDING THE ADOPTED BUDGET FOR FY  
2025-26 TO REFLECT THE REVENUES, EXPENDITURES,  
APPROPRIATIONS AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS  
BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT;  
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Section 166.241 authorizes a municipality to amend its adopted budget anytime during the fiscal year or within sixty (60) days after the end of the fiscal year for which the budget applied; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 166.241 (4)(c) provides the process for a municipality to amend an adopted budget when the amendment will change the expenditures and revenues; and

**WHEREAS**, the FY 2025-26 adopted budget did not reflect the revenue, expenditures, appropriations and other miscellaneous adjustments reflected herein; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed budget amendment is still within the allotted time pursuant to Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administration proposes that the FY 2025-26 adopted budget be amended to include the following transactions:

1. Electric Bus Generators – \$300,000. This will be funded by General Fund reserves;
2. Transfer to Capital Projects Fund – \$776,110. This will be funded by General Fund reserves;
3. EV Portable Chargers – \$73,110. This will be funded by a transfer from the General Fund;
4. Atlantic Shores – \$100,000. This will be funded by a transfer from the General Fund;

42 5. Pedestrian Crossing Project – \$150,000. This will be funded by a transfer from the  
43 General Fund;

45 6. Mooring Field – \$453,000. This will be funded by a transfer from the General Fund;

48 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best  
49 interest of the City and its residents to amend the FY 2025-26 adopted budget as reflected  
50 in the attachment; and

52 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that this proposed  
53 budget amendment is timely under Florida Statutes 166.241 and is being adopted in the  
54 same manner as the original adoption of the FY 2025-26 budget.

56 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY**  
57 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

59 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are confirmed as true and  
60 incorporated herein.

62 **SECTION 2. Adoption of Budget Amendment.** The Mayor and City  
63 Commission hereby adopt the budget amendment to the FY 2025-26 adopted budget as  
64 set forth in Attachments A of this ordinance.

66 **SECTION 3. Conflict.** All ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, or parts  
67 of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of the conflict.

69 **SECTION 4. Severability.** Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by  
70 a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of  
71 this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part that is declared to be  
72 invalid.  
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74 **SECTION 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon  
75 adoption.
