TO PERFORM AN ASSESSMENT AND SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE 8 9 EPA AS REQUIRED BY THE AMERICAN WATER **INFRASTRUCTURE ACT OF 2018, IN ACCORDANCE** 10 WITH RFP #FY2013-2014-006, CONTINUING SERVICES 11 CONTRACT, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED 12 13 \$154,245; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 14 15 WHEREAS, the America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018 ("the Act") requires 16 17 that all community water systems serving populations greater than 3,300 persons assess 18 the risks to, and resilience of, its system (the "Risk and Resilience Assessment" or "RRA"); 19 and 20 WHEREAS, the RRA shall include assessments of i) risk to the system from malevolent acts and natural hazards; ii) resilience of the infrastructure, including 21 22 supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA), iii) (SCADA)/cyber resilience; iv) 23 monitoring practices of the system; financial infrastructure of the system; v) use, storage, 24 and handling of various chemicals by the system and vi) operation and maintenance of

the system; and

WHEREAS, within six months of completion of the RRA, America's Water
Infrastructure Act of 2018 also requires a letter of certification to EPA that the Emergency
Response Plan (ERP) for a utility is updated, and at least every 5 years thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the ERP can be developed based on existing emergency plans such as the City's Hurricane Plan but is required to include response protocols for any type of emergency or event identified as a threat during the RRA; and

WHEREAS, assessment shall be finalized, and the report submitted to the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) by June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, staff solicited the services of Hazen and Sawyer to perform this assessment and write the report, utilizing the Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA), Continuing Professional Architectural and Engineering Services, RFP #FY 2013-2014-006, awarded on November 19, 2014; and

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WHEREAS, Hazen and Sawyer submitted a cost proposal in the amount of\$154,245; and

41 WHEREAS, Staff recommends authorizing the city manager to approve utilizing 42 Hazen and Sawyer, Inc. to perform an assessment and submit a report to the EPA as 43 required by the American Water Infrastructure Act of 2018, in accordance with RFP 44 #FY2013-2014-006, Continuing Services Contract, for a total amount not to exceed 45 \$154,245.
