11 12	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-8(2), Professional Services, of the City of Hallandale
13	Beach Code of Ordinances, contracts for professional services involving peculiar skill, ability,
14	experience or expertise, which are in their nature unique and not subject to competitive bidding,
15	are exempt from the competitive bidding requirements of this article; however, a formal written
16	contract, approved by the commission, shall be required for all such contracts in excess of twenty-
17	five thousand (\$25,000.00) dollars; and
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19	WHEREAS, staff is currently working on the strategic focus areas and goals developed
20	based on the Strategic Plan that was approved by the City Commission in August of 2019. These
21	include Finance and Budget, Organizational Capacity and Infrastructure/Projects; and
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23	WHEREAS, the John Scott Dailey Florida Institute of Government at Florida Atlantic
24	University, in partnership with Trainnovations, is also currently providing leadership training for
25	supervisory, managerial, and senior leaders within the City, through the Leadership Academy, a
26	series of learning modules for supervisory and managerial employees; and
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28	WHEREAS, for Fiscal Year 2020/2021 the total fee for the leadership academy program
29	is \$24,936. However, the Interim City Manager seeks to exceed the threshold for Professional
30 21	Services and enter into an agreement with Trainnovations, for an additional \$15,000, to provide
31 32	professional consulting services to assist the Strategic Focus Teams to bring solutions in alignment with the Strategic Focus Areas and Goals; and
33	alignment with the Strategic Focus Areas and Goals, and
34	WHEREAS City Administration recommends the John Scott Dailey Florida Institute of
35	Government at Florida Atlantic University, in partnership with Trainnovations, for their specific
36	training program focused on government and management practices; and

39	of Trainnovations to perform management training is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale
