24	expenditures, appropriations and other miscellaneous adjustments reflected herein; and		
25	WHEREAS, this proposed budget amendment is still within the allotted time		
26	pursuant to Florida Statutes; and		
27 28	WHEREAS, the City Administration proposes that the FY 2021-2022 adopted

94	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and
95	incorporated herein.

97	SECTION 2. Adoption of Budget Amendment. The Mayor and City
98	Commission hereby adopt the budget amendment to the FY 2021-2022 adopted budget
99	as set forth in Attachments A of this ordinance.
100	
101	<b>SECTION 3. Conflict.</b> All ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, or parts
102	of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of the conflict.
103	
104	SECTION 4. Severability. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by
105	a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of
106	this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part that is declared to be
107	invalid.

109	SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon
110	adoption.
