2 RESOLUTION NO. 2018-

3 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY  
4 COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH,  
5 FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
6 MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL  
7 AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY TO  
8 REESTABLISH, REIMPOSE, AND RELEVY THE  
9 CURRENT SIX-CENT (\$0.06) LOCAL OPTION GAS TAX  
10 ON EVERY GALLON OF MOTOR FUEL AND SPECIAL  
11 FUEL SOLD IN BROWARD COUNTY, EFFECTIVE  
12 SEPTEMBER 1, 2018 THROUGH AND INCLUDING  
13 DECEMBER 31, 2047; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE  
14 DATE.

15 WHEREAS, Section 336.025, Florida Statutes, authorizes Broward County to  
16 establish a six-cent (\$0.06) local option gas tax on every gallon of motor fuel and special  
17 fuel sold in the County and taxed under the provisions of Chapter 206, Florida Statutes,  
18 for a period not to exceed thirty (30) years; and

19 WHEREAS, proceeds of the local option gas tax may be used solely for  
20 "transportation expenditures" as defined in Section 336.025(7), Florida Statutes, with  
21 distribution of the proceeds determined pursuant to an interlocal agreement (ILA) between  
22 the County and eligible municipalities representing a majority of the population of the  
23 incorporated area within the County; and

24 WHEREAS, cities within Broward County ("cities"), including Hallandale Beach,  
25 and Broward County ("County") have entered into three ILAs for the distribution of the  
26 proceeds of the local option gas taxes levied by the County; and

27 WHEREAS, the three ILA's include: 1) The original local option gas tax adopted in  
28 1983 and renewed in 1988, which provides for cities to receive 37.5% of the proceeds of  
29 the six-cent (\$0.06) local option gas tax, 2) The additional local option gas tax levied in  
30 1994, which provides for cities to receive 51.27% of the three-cent (\$0.03) gas tax, and  
31 3) The transit gas tax levied in 2001, which provides for cities to receive 26% of the  
32 proceeds of the one-cent (\$0.01) local option gas tax; and

34 WHEREAS, the ILA for the original local option gas tax will expire August 31, 2018  
35 unless reestablished by the County; and
