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RESOLUTION NO. 2023 - 033

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, FINDING UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCES TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT REQUIREMENTS AND SUSTAINABILITY POLICY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF CITY VEHICLES; AUTHORIZING VEHICLE PURCHASES THROUGH DECEMBER 30, 2025; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000.00, except as specifically provided in that section, shall be based, wherever possible, on competitive bids Code of Ordinances, Code of Ordinances, Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 23, Section 23-8 of the City Code of Ordinances, Exception to Bid Requirements, (5) *Unique circumstances* provides an exception to competitive bidding where the City Commission finds unique circumstances establish that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the City; however, such purchases in excess of \$50,000.00 shall require a formal, written contract approved by the City Commission and the City Commission, upon request by the City Manager, may waive the requirement for a formal written contract when such a contract would not be in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 23, Section 23-10 of the City Code of Ordinances, Appropriations required, provides that no obligation for expenditures of City funds may be incurred except pursuant to, and only to the extent of, a specific appropriation of funds in the budget, but in an emergency involving urgent or extreme matters of public health, safety or welfare, the City Manager may exceed the \$50,000.00 monetary limitation, provided that, on the same business day that he/she takes such action, the City Manager

35 shall request that a special commission meeting be held at the earliest possible time, to
36 ratify that action; and

38 **WHEREAS**, on March 28, 2023, the City Manager advised the City Commission
39 of the unprecedented supply chain shortages as relate to vehicle purchases that continue
40 through 2023, as cities across the country continue to try to replace vehicles that are
41 outside of their useful life; and

43 **WHEREAS**, staff has encountered significant difficulty purchasing vehicles
44 through authorized cooperative contracts due to supply shortages and limited inventory
45 at local area dealerships which has caused delays and additional expenses in providing
46 services; and

47
48 **WHEREAS**, staff requests a finding of Unique Circumstances to waive competitive
49 procurement requirements for the purchase of vehicles, authorization for vehicle
50 purchases that exceed the City Manager's threshold of \$50,000.00 for vehicles indicated
51 in the attached Exhibit A and for replacement of any vehicles involved in accidents or that
52 suffer sudden catastrophic mechanical failure, and waiver of Sustainability Process Policy
53 2009.004, which requires the purchase of electric and/or hybrid fleet vehicles where
54 appropriate, through December 30, 2025.

56 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE TY**
57 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

59 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

61 **SECTION 2.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby find unique circumstances
62 to waive competitive procurement requirements and authorize the purchase of vehicles
63 indicated in the attached Exhibit A and for replacement of any vehicles involved in
64 accidents or that suffer sudden catastrophic mechanical failure through December 30,
65 2025. Given the nature of vehicle purchases from dealerships as inventory is available,

66 the requirement for formal written contact is also waived. The purchasing authority
67 pursuant to this authorization shall be limited to funds budgeted or available for vehicle
68 replacement within the fiscal year.


