RESOLUTION NO. 2017-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA OPPOSING ANY AMENDMENT TO THE BROWARD COUNTY CHARTER WHICH WOULD PREEMPT OR LIMIT A MUNICIPALITY'S LEGAL ABILITY TO REGULATE THE LOCATION OF PUBLIC BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES OR APPURTENANCES, INCLUDING COUNTY FACILITIES, WITHIN ITS MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES; PROVIDING FOR DISTRIBUTION OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR BROWARD COUNTY AND THE BROWARD COUNTY CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, at the recommendation of the Broward County administration, the Broward County Charter Review Commission's Infrastructure Subcommittee is considering a proposed amendment to the Broward County Charter which would restrict a municipality's ability to regulate site applications by Broward County for a public purpose if the application is consistent with the municipality's zoning designation, comprehensive plan, land use policies and land development regulations (the "Proposed Charter Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the Proposed Charter Amendment is an overt attempt by Broward County to contravene municipal home rule and to restrict a municipality's ability to regulate the location of buildings, structures or appurtenances within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, in the past Broward County has criticized the Florida Legislature for imposing restrictions, obligations and unfunded mandates on local government, yet the Proposed Charter Amendment is seeking to do essentially the same thing at the county/municipal level; and

WHEREAS, Broward County and the municipalities within the county, collectively through the Broward League of Cities, have been working together in recent years to foster partnerships in an effort to better serve the citizens and residents of the county; and

WHEREAS, the Proposed Charter Amendment threatens to strain the relationship between the county and the municipalities by infringing on municipal home rule authority; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission find it to be in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to oppose any amendment to the Broward County Charter that would preempt or limit a municipality's legal ability to regulate the location of public buildings, structures or appurtenances, including county facilities, within its municipal boundaries.
