WHEREAS, on August 5, 2020, the City Commission of Hallandale Beach adopted Resolution 2020-054 authorizing continuing service agreements solicited through RFP #2018-2019-012 — Continuing Professional Architectural and Engineering Services pursuant to Section 287.055, Fla. Stats., the Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA); and

WHEREAS, while 29 electric vehicles (EV) are currently deployed across various City of Hallandale Beach departments, expanding the number of charging locations can minimize downtime ensuring City vehicles are readily available for service, and additional fast-charging capabilities will expedite the recharging process, further reducing idle time and increasing overall City productivity; and

WHEREAS, City staff received an estimate from Hazen and Sawyer, an awarded Consultant selected through RFP # FY 2018-2019-022 - CCNA Continuing Professional Architectural and Engineering Services, for an amount not to exceed One Hundred, Twenty-Four Thousand, Five Hundred and Fifty-Eight Dollars (\$124,558) for design,

permitting, and bid phase services for the construction and installation of up to five additional electric vehicle Dual-Port (EV) fast chargers at the original EV charger location within the public works compound, which will add 10 charging spaces for our (non-City shuttle bus) EV fleet; and

WHEREAS, the estimated construction cost for the charger infrastructure is \$633,750.00 for the five chargers, electrical components, duct work, earth work, etc; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it in the public interest to authorize the City Manager to enter into a CCNA work authorization with Hazen and Sawyer in a not to exceed amount of One Hundred, Twenty-Four Thousand, Five Hundred and Fifty-Eight Dollars (\$124,558) for design, permitting, and bid phase services for the construction and installation of up to five additional electric vehicle Dual-Port (EV) fast chargers at the original EV charger location within the public works compound, which will add 10 charging spaces for the (non-City shuttle bus) EV fleet, and authorize the City Manager to execute all relating documents.
