RESOLUTION NO. 2024 -

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER FOR THE FY 2021-2022-016 WATER TREATMENT PLANT REVERSE OSMOSIS SKID ADDITION PROJECT AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FOUR THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$104,150) TO ADD AN OWNER SUPPLIED 24" MODULATING VALVE AND PNEUMATIC ACTUATOR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies, and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000, except as specifically provided in that section, shall be based, wherever possible, on competitive bids Code of Ordinances, Code of Ordinances; and

 WHEREAS, pursuant to Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23, Section 23-12 Procedures for purchases in excess of \$50,000, item (7) Change Orders, any change in the contract price, scope of work or time for completion of any project following the award of a contract shall be by a written change order, approved by the City Manager and executed with the same formalities as the contract, the City Manager may approve change orders so long as the total sum of all change orders does not exceed the total amount awarded by the City Commission by more than either ten percent of the contract cost or \$50,000, whichever is less, and the scope of any project may not be changed without prior approval of the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2023, the City Commission awarded Bid FY 2021-2022-016 Water Treatment Plant Reverse Osmosis Skid Addition by Resolution 2023-025 to Cardinal Contractors, Inc. in the amount of Four Million, Two Hundred, Eighty-Four Thousand, Six Hundred and Eighteen Dollars (\$4,284,618), which, inclusive of a 10% contingency is Four Million, Seven Hundred, Thirteen Thousand, Seventy-Nine Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$4,713,079.80); and

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WHEREAS, Staff obtained a cost proposal for a change order in the amount of One Hundred Four Thousand, One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$104,150) to expand the project scope by adding an owner supplied 24" modulating valve and pneumatic actuator to provide a control point to modulate the raw water flow to the water plant and reduce water hammers; and

WHEREAS, this additional scope was previously approved in connection with a different Capital Improvements Project, funded in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000), but by purchasing the valve for Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) separately and contracting with Cardinal Contractors, Inc. to install it as part of the work they are performing for the installation of the Reverse Osmosis Skid project, the City will realize a cost savings of Three Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand, Eight Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$355,850) to the CIP Project; and

 WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission authorize a change order for the FY 2021-2022-016 Water Treatment Plant Reverse Osmosis Skid Addition project agreement in the amount of One Hundred Four Thousand, One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$104,150) to add an owner supplied 24" modulating valve and pneumatic actuator, and authorize the City Manager to execute all relating documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

 SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize a change order for the FY 2021-2022-016 Water Treatment Plant Reverse Osmosis Skid Addition project agreement in the amount of One Hundred Four Thousand, One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$104,150) to add an owner supplied 24" modulating valve, and authorize the City Manager to execute all relating documents.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
