4 AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
5 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, SUBMITTING
6 TO REFERENDUM AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER OF
7 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH TO PROVIDE FOR EX-
8 OFFICIO APPOINTMENTS TO OTHER BOARDS; PROVIDING
9 THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE
10 QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE
11 BEACH ON THE NOVEMBER 8, 2022 GENERAL ELECTION
12 BALLOT; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR
13 CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND
14 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 WHEREAS, Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, as amended, provides for the process for
17 amendment of municipal charters which includes submission of a proposed amendment by
18 ordinance to a referendum vote; and

19 WHEREAS, the Charter Review Committee for the City of Hallandale beach has reviewed
20 the Charter and proposed certain amendments thereto; and

21 WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that amendment of the charter in the
22 manner stated herein is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
24 HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

25 SECTION 1. If approved, Article III "City Commission," Section 3.07 "Prohibitions" of the
26 Charter shall be amended as follows:

27 Sec: 3.07: - Prohibitions.

28 (1) Holding other office. Except where authorized by law, no commissioner
29 shall hold any other Hallandale Beach city office, Hallandale Beach city
30 employment, or other elected public office during the term for which he or she
31 was elected to the commission. This paragraph shall not apply to positions
32 designated as ex-officio appointments by the city commission.

36 **SECTION 2.** The Ballot Title shall be as follows:

37 EX-OFFICIO APPOINTMENTS TO OTHER BOARDS

38 **SECTION 3.** At the General Municipal Election on November 8, 2022, the following
39 question shall be placed on the ballot for consideration by the qualified electors of the City of
40 Hallandale Beach, Florida, and shall read as follows:

41 Shall the Hallandale Beach Charter be amended to provide that
42 members of the city commission may serve on other boards, as
43 appointed by the city commission, to represent the interests of the
44 city?

45 This proposed Charter amendment will have no financial impact on
46 the City.

49 **SECTION 4. Advertisement.** The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to
50 advertise the referendum election contemplated herein all in accordance with the Code of
51 Ordinances and the State of Florida Election Code.

52 **SECTION 5. Conflict.** All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City
53 of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent
54 of such conflict.

55 **SECTION 6. Severability.** Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court
56 of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a
57 whole, or any part thereof, other that the part declared to be invalid.

58 **SECTION 7. Effective Date.** The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective
59 immediately upon adoption. The amendment contemplated herein shall become effective, if
60 approved, upon certification of the vote in accordance with Florida Law.
