SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AWARDDING BID # FY 2024-2025-09 LIFT STATION #4 REHABILITATION TO SOUTHERN UNDERGROUND INDUSTRIES, INC., AS THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER, IN AN AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION, NINE HUNDRED, FIFTEEN THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$1,915,950) AND AUTHORIZE A TEN (10%) CONTINGENCY, FOR A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION, ONE HUNDRED, SEVEN THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND FORTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$2,107,545); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

This agenda item seeks City Commission's approval of staff's recommendation to award Bid # FY 2024-2025-09 Lift Station #4 Rehabilitation to Southern Underground Industries, Inc as the

lowest responsive bidder, in an amount of \$1,915,950 plus a 10% contingency (\$191,595.00) for a total not to exceed the amount of \$2,107,545.

Background:

On October 6, 2021, the City Commission approved Resolution No. 2021-124 authorizing the use of the continuing service agreement to retain the services of KCI Technologies, Inc., to design the Lift Station #4 Rehabilitation Project in an amount not to exceed \$204,410 in accordance with RFP #2018-2019-012 – Continuing Professional Architectural and Engineering Services. KCI Technologies, Inc., submitted a design proposal to the Public Works Engineering Division on July 15, 2021 (Exhibit 2).

The intent of the project is to rehabilitate and improve the existing Sewer Lift Station #4 located in the Three Islands neighborhood by replacing and upgrading mechanical and electrical equipment as well as replacing the submersible pumps to improve system performance, increase system efficiency and reduce system maintenance.

Current Situation:

The release notice for the Bid was sent to vendors from the City's Vendor list and pertinent vendors that have a City Business Tax License to operate in the City.

Staff evaluated the responses and determined that Southern Underground Industries, Inc., is the lowest responsive bidder (Exhibit 3).

If approved by the City Commission, the construction contract will be finalized, and the estimated Project Schedule is as follows:

Commission Award	June 4, 2025
Notice to Proceed	July, 2025
Anticipated Construction Start	September, 2025
Anticipated Construction Completion	August, 2026

Staff have reviewed the bids and the attached Award Recommendation Memorandum (Exhibit 4). The Department of Public Works recommends awarding BID # FY2024-2025-09 to Southern Underground Industries, Inc.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Code of Ordinances, in accordance with Procurement Code Section 23-4, Competitive bidding required, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000.00 shall be based on competitive bids. Furthermore, Section 23-6, Award of contract, the City Manager, shall have the authority to recommend to the City Commission award of contracts.

Cost Benefit:

The benefits from the construction of Lift Station #4 will ensure the needs of increased development intensity are met. Lift Station #4 will incorporate newer design standards such as easier access to the controls, valves and pumps which will significantly reduce the time and personnel required to perform regular maintenance, thereby reducing Operations and Maintenance costs.
