14 15	WHEREAS, Section 166.241 authorizes a municipality to amend its adopted
16	budget anytime during the fiscal year or within sixty (60) days after the end of the fiscal
17	year for which the budget applied; and

19	WHEREAS, Section 166.241 (4)(c) provides the process for a municipality to
20	amend an adopted budget when the amendment will change the expenditures and
21	revenues; and
22 23	WHEREAS, the FY 2024-2025 adopted budget did not reflect the revenue,
24	expenditures, appropriations and other miscellaneous adjustments reflected herein; and
25	WHEREAS, this proposed budget amendment is still within the allotted time
26	pursuant to Florida Statutes; and
27 28	WHEREAS, the City Administration proposes that the FY 2024-2025 adopted
29	budget be amended to include the following transactions:
30 31 32 33	 Reversal of Legal Judgement Fund – \$4,300,000. This expenditure will be funded as a transfer from General Liability Fund reserves;
34 35 36	 International City Manager Association Fellow Program – \$51,714. This expenditure will be funded by General Fund reserves;
37 38 39 40	 Additional Police Officers – \$440,587. This expenditure will be funded by General Fund reserves;

41 42 43	 Citywide Records Modernization and Compliance Initiative – \$350,921. This expenditure will be funded by a transfer from the General Fund reserves; 	
44 45 46	Additional Accrual Settlement \$20,000. This expenditure will be funded by a transfer from the General Fund;	
47 48 49	 Transfer to Transportation Fund – \$24,350. This expenditure will be funded by General Fund reserves; 	
50 51 52	 Transfer to Capital Projects Fund – \$184,444. This expenditure will be funded by General Fund reserves; 	
53 54 55	 Reclassification of Heavy Equipment Operator for Project Manager I – \$24,350. This expenditure will be funded by a transfer from the General Fund reserves; 	
56 57 58	 Parks Capital Improvement Projects – \$148,194. This expenditure will be funded as a transfer from the General Fund; 	
59 60 61	 Replacement of LPR Camera - \$36,250. This expenditure will be funded as a transfer form the General Fund reserves; 	
62 63 64	 Three Islands Project - \$4,600,000. This expenditure will be funded by a transfer from the General Fund reserves; 	
65 66 67	 Establish 2025 Utility Revenue Bond Fund – \$72,000,000. This expenditure will be funded by reimbursements from the Utility Revenue Bond Proceeds; 	
68 69 70	 General Liability Fund – \$4,336,250. This expenditure will be funded by General Liability Fund reserves; 	
71	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best	
72	interest of the City and its residents to amend the FY 2024-2025 adopted budget as	
73	reflected in the attachment; and

75	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that this proposed	
76	budget amendment is timely under Florida Statutes 166.241 and is being adopted in the	
77	same manner as the original adoption of the FY 2024-2025 budget.

79	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY	
80	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

82	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and
83	incorporated herein.
84	
85	SECTION 2. Adoption of Budget Amendment. The Mayor and City
86	Commission hereby adopt the budget amendment to the FY 2024-2025 adopted budget
87	as set forth in Attachments A of this ordinance.
88 89	SECTION 3. Conflict. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, or parts
90	of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of the conflict.
91	
92	SECTION 4. Severability. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by
93	a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of
94	this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part that is declared to be
95	invalid.

97	SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon
98	adoption.
