L5	Ordinances, purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services,

L7	section, shall be based, wherever possible, on competitive bids Code of Ordinances, Code

20	WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Chapter		
21	23, Section 23-12, Procedures for purchases in excess of \$50,000, (4) Rejection of Bids, the		
22	City Commission may authorize City Manager to: a) Reject all bids; or b) reject all bids and		
23	re-advertise; and

25	WHEREAS, Chapter 23, Section 23-8, City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances,		
26	creates an exemption from competitive procurement requirements where no bid has been		
27	received after publication of a bid proposal; however, such purchases in excess of \$50,000.0		
28	require a formal, written contract approved by the city commission; and

30	WHEREAS, the City previously went out for bid RFP FY 2020-2021-007 for Bluesten		
31	and OB Johnson concessions, but was unable to negotiate a contract with the only bidder		
32	(one of two total bidders) that bid on all parks because the vendor was unable to demonstrate		
13	financial capacity: and		

34	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach released RFP# FY2022-2023-011		
35	Concession Services for OB Johnson Park, Peter Bluesten Park, and South City Beach Par		
36	("the RFP"); and		
37			
38	WHEREAS, only one bid was submitted and the City Evaluation Committee		
39	determined there was insufficient information to effectively evaluate the proposal given the		
40	absence of an operation plan, information on who would be in charge, staffing levels, and		
41	how the bidder proposed to transition from offering primarily mobile concession services to		
42	operating out of concession stands. Effectively, no responsible, responsive bids were		
43	received which could be evaluated; and		
44			
45	WHEREAS, given the multiple unsuccessful attempts to obtain viable bids via		
46	competitive procurement solicitations, staff intends to identify and recommend a		
47	procurement method other than competitive bidding in order to obtain the needed services;		
48	and

50	WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it in the public		
51	interest to authorize the City Manager to reject all bids submitted in response to RFP#		
52	FY2022-2023-011, Concession Services for OB Johnson Park, Peter Bluesten Park, and		
53	South City Beach Park, and authorize the City Manager to proceed in the best interest of the		
54	City.

56	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
