Utility CIP Funding Plan The City is in the process of implementing a \$253M CIP Plan for water, wastewater, and stormwater utility infrastructure to address various system failures. Without any alternative funding, the plan includes the issuance of utility revenue bonds with a total value of up to \$207.4M.

Multi-phase Utility Rate Study As part of the bond issuance process, the City engaged an outside consultant to perform a multi-phase utility rate study. This ensures that the rates charged to customers are sufficient to cover the CIP Plan and related debt service. The updated analysis of Phase I to the rate study was adopted by the City Commission on June 21, 2023.

Water, Wastewater & Stormwater study results

Phase I of the study identified the need for rate increases through FY2028. The recommended annual rate increases for FY2024 are 17%, 7%, and 10%, respectively, for water, wastewater, and stormwater utilities.

Per City Code of Ordinances, a residential ERU, or equivalent residential unit, is any structure which provides living accommodations for a single family. An ERU is charged a monthly flat rate for stormwater drainage fees.
