13 14	WHEREAS, The mission of the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency ("HBCRA") is to promote economic development and enhance the quality of life by eliminating
14	and preventing blighted conditions through the facilitation of community partnerships, business
16	growth, job creation, and neighborhood rehabilitation; and

18	WHEREAS, during the past year, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA and HBCRA
19	administration have discussed various art initiatives within the City of Hallandale Beach ("City");

22	WHEREAS, in March of 2012, the HBCRA adopted the Community Redevelopment Plan
23	wherein specific areas within the Community Redevelopment Area ("CRA") boundaries were
24 25	designated as Special Redevelopment Areas and Districts, and the Community Redevelopment
25 26	Plan also stated that the HBCRA's strategic priorities included creating an image and sense of community for the CRA; and

28	WHEREAS, to maintain the momentum of redevelopment throughout the City, the HBCRA
29	conducted intensive research on filming incentives in various cities throughout the states with the
30	intent of the research is to help determine the types of incentives that the HBCRA could offer to
31	film producers that would ultimately attract more film producers to the City and, by extension,
32	motivate more investors to open businesses in the City; and

34	WHEREAS, the use of existing incentive modules that have been validated by other cities
35	would enable the HBCRA would be able to eliminate the potential for errors, and
36 37	WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to establish the Hallandale
38	Beach Film Incentive Program and allocate \$25,000 for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

40	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS
41	OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY:
42	Section 1. Recitals. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and
43	incorporated into this Resolution.
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44 Section 2. <u>Establishment of Hallandale Beach Film Incentive Program</u>. The Hallandale 45 Beach Film Incentive Program is hereby established.

46 Section 3. <u>Allocation of Funds to the Hallandale Beach Film Incentive Program</u>. The 47 allocation of \$25,000 to the Hallandale Beach Film Incentive Program for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 48 is hereby approved.

49 Section 4. Implementation of the Hallandale Beach Film Incentive Program. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary and appropriate to implement 50 the Hallandale Beach Film Incentive Program including promulgating policies and an application 51 process similar to those of the City of Miami Beach provided that the maximum amount of the 52 Film Incentive would be \$5,000, to be awarded to the five (5) most qualified film producers; and 53 54 the Executive Director is hereby authorized to appropriate and expend funds for related expenses that do not to exceed the spending limits of the Executive Director with any expenditures which 55 exceed the Executive Director's spending limits shall be brought back before the Board of 56 57 Directors of the HBCRA for approval.

58 Section 5. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
