Staff Summary:

Background:

In October 1993, the City Commission established an awards program to recognize major landscaping beautification improvements within the community. The City Commission directed the Beautification Advisory Board to annually select properties with outstanding improvements in the area of façcade treatment, renovations, and landscaping.

The Hallandale Beach Beautification Advisory Board works diligently to select award nominees. The

Board recommends that awards be given to seventeen (17) recipients this year (Exhibit 1).

This program encourages residents and property owners to take pride in beautifying and maintaining the façade and grounds of their property. This award program recognizes the effort that businesses and residents put forth to beautify and provide an attractive look to their properties.
