12	WHEREAS, on March 28, 2018, a Request for Proposals FY 2017-2018-008
13	(CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION SYSTEM
14	INSTALLATION AND LEASE) was released on behalf of the Hallandale Beach Police
15	Department; and
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17	WHEREAS, on June 20, 2018, the City Commission approved Resolution 2018-
18	075 authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with Vetted Security Solutions
19	in an amount not to exceed \$988,140 over a five-year term. However, funding for the
20	project was reallocated and the contract was never executed; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, since the award of the RFP, license plate reader (LPR) technology,
23	software and pricing has evolved. The LPR cameras proposed in the Vetted Security
24	Solutions proposal has been replaced by a next generation version. The pricing for LPR
25	technology has become more competitive and decreased; and
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27	WHEREAS, Section 23-12 of the City's Code permits the City Commission to
28	authorize the City Manager to reject all bids and re-advertise a new solicitation; and
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30	WHEREAS, City Administration has identified an alternative option for providing
31	the services; and
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33	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission find it is in the best interests of the
34	residents of the City to reject all proposals and rescind the previous award based on the
35	City's current needs and situation.
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37	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
38	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
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40	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.
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42	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby rescind and repeal the
43	award for LPR technology to Vetted Security Solutions in Resolution 2018-075, and
44	authorize the City Manager to reject all proposals received pursuant to RFP FY 2017-
45	2018-008.

48	its passage and adoption.
