**RESOLUTION NO. 2020 -**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REJECT ALL PROPOSALS FOR RFP # FY2017-2018-008 LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION SYSTEM INSTALLATION AND LEASE; RESCINDING AND REPEALING RESOLUTION 2018-075 AWARDED TO VETTED SECURITY SOLUTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 28, 2018, a Request for Proposals FY 2017-2018-008 (CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION SYSTEM INSTALLATION AND LEASE) was released on behalf of the Hallandale Beach Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 20, 2018, the City Commission approved Resolution 2018-075 authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with Vetted Security Solutions in an amount not to exceed \$988,140 over a five-year term. However, funding for the project was reallocated and the contract was never executed; and

**WHEREAS**, since the award of the RFP, license plate reader (LPR) technology, software and pricing has evolved. The LPR cameras proposed in the Vetted Security Solutions proposal has been replaced by a next generation version. The pricing for LPR technology has become more competitive and decreased; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 23-12 of the City's Code permits the City Commission to authorize the City Manager to reject all bids and re-advertise a new solicitation; and

**WHEREAS**, City Administration has identified an alternative option for providing the services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission find it is in the best interests of the residents of the City to reject all proposals and rescind the previous award based on the City's current needs and situation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby rescind and repeal the award for LPR technology to Vetted Security Solutions in Resolution 2018-075, and authorize the City Manager to reject all proposals received pursuant to RFP FY 2017-2018-008.

**SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
