**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING UTILIZATION OF SOURCEWELL CONTRACT # 032824-RTG TO PURCHASE A SEWER CRANE TRUCK FROM RUSH TRUCK CENTERS OF FLORIDA, INC. FOR A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED, EIGHTY-NINE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$189,450); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

16           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances,  
17 Section 23-5, Competitive procurement required, procurement mechanisms (a), all  
18 purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services in excess  
19 of the delegated spending authority shall be based on a competitive procurement  
20 process and Section 23-9, Award, (e), the City Manager may award procurements  
21 within the delegated spending authority, and all other procurements, except  
22 emergency procurements, require commission approval for award; and  
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24           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances,  
25 Section 23-5 Competitive procurement required; procurement mechanisms,  
26 Subsection (3) Cooperative purchasing, the City may procure goods or services  
27 through a variety of arrangements whereby two or more public entities have the  
28 opportunity to purchase from the same supplier or multiple suppliers using a single  
29 competitive procurement mechanism; and  
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31           **WHEREAS**, Sourcewell, a municipal contracting agency, allows government  
32 entities to cooperatively procure equipment and services at discounted rates. By  
33 leveraging Sourcewell's cooperative pricing, the City ensures competitive costs and  
34 streamlined procurement, enabling staff to respond quickly and effectively to emerging  
35 needs; and  
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38           **WHEREAS**, the City of Hallandale Beach Fleet Department has implemented  
39 a replacement plan that balances the cost of ownership with the operability of fleet  
40 assets, considering factors such as age, utilization, and anticipated surplus value on  
41 the secondary market, and based on this analysis, the vehicle requested for  
42 replacement has been approved for FY 2026; and

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44           **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends replacement of Unit 1224, a 2016 Ford F350  
45 with a utility body and auxiliary crane, a truck specially outfitted to support sewer  
46 department personnel in maintaining, repairing, and servicing sewer lift station  
47 pumps and related infrastructure that carries the tools, equipment, and materials  
48 necessary to safely access lift stations, remove and reinstall pumps, perform  
49 mechanical and electrical repairs, and address system malfunctions in the field; and

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51           **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to  
52 be in the public interest to authorize utilization of Sourcewell contract # 032824-RTG  
53 to purchase a sewer crane truck (replacing Unit 1224) for the Department of Public  
54 Works from Rush Truck Centers of Florida, Inc. for a not to exceed amount not to  
55 exceed amount of One Hundred, Eighty-Nine Thousand, Four Hundred and Fifty  
56 Dollars (\$189,450), and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.

66 Works from Rush Truck Centers of Florida, Inc. for a not to exceed amount not to  
67 exceed amount of One Hundred, Eighty-Nine Thousand, Four Hundred and Fifty  
68 Dollars (\$189,450), and authorize the City Manager to execute relating documents.
