A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AWARDING BID # FY 2023-2024-07 16 INCH WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT ON ATLANTIC SHORES BLVD TO JVA ENGINEERING CONTRACTOR INC. AS THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION, EIGHT HUNDRED, NINETY-EIGHT THOUSAND AND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,898,200); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

This agenda item seeks City Commission's approval to award Bid # FY 2023-2024-07 16-inch Water Main Replacement on Atlantic Shores Blvd. to JVA Engineering Contractor Inc. as the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$ 1,898,200 plus a 10% contingency (\$189,820) for a not-to-exceed amount of \$2,088,020 to complete the construction of the project.

Background:

On August 5, 2020, the City Commission approved Resolution No. 2020-054 authorizing continuing service agreements to be awarded in accordance with the Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) per RFP # FY2018-2019-012, to a selected group of design professional firms (Exhibit 2).

On June 17, 2021, the City entered into a Work Authorization Agreement with R.J. Behar & Company, Inc. to complete the design of the 16-Inch Watermain Replacement Project in the amount of \$141,119.49 (Exhibit 3). This watermain is along Atlantic Shores between NE 14th Ave. and Three Island Blvd.

The intent of the project is to replace an existing 12-inch watermain on Atlantic Shores Blvd. with a new 16-inch watermain from NE 14th Ave. to Three Islands Blvd. This project will install approximately 879 feet of the new watermain using horizontal directional drilling technology to pass beneath the bottom surface of the De Soto Waterway. The directional drilled line will be 18" in diameter to match the internal diameter of the 16" PVC waterline. In addition to this work, this will also be a new 8" PVC watermain, tee connections, gate valves, air release valves, sleeves, and other water utility related work.

The work includes the abandonment of the existing 12" watermain that is being replaced. Additional to this work is the removal of the existing 12-inch watermain located on the Atlantic Shores bridge crossing the De Soto Waterway.

Staff has reviewed the bids and the attached Award Information Memorandum (Exhibit 5). The Department of Public Works recommends awarding BID # FY2023-2024-07 JVA Engineering Contractor Inc.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, Competitive Bidding Required, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000.00 shall be based on competitive bids. Furthermore, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-6, Award of Contract, the City Manager shall have the authority to recommend to the City Commission award of contracts.

Cost Benefit:

The benefits from the construction of the 16-Inch Water Main Replacement on Atlantic Shores Blvd. will improve water pressure and flow within the corridor. This improvement will reduce the cost of future repairs, which will significantly impact the time and personnel required to perform regular maintenance/repair, thereby reducing operations and maintenance costs.
