LANDING” TO ALLOW CITY MANAGER TO ALLOW
AIRCRAFT LANDINGS ON CITY PROPERTY; PROVIDING
FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS;
PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

STAFF SUMMARY:

The proposed ordinance would permit the City Manager to authorize aircraft landings on City-owned or controlled property.

Why Action is Necessary:

Amendments to the City Code must be approved by the City Commission.
