10 11	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-8(2), Professional Services, of the City of Hallandale
12	Beach Code of Ordinances, contracts for professional services involving peculiar skill, ability,
13	experience or expertise, which are in their nature unique and not subject to competitive bidding,
14	are exempt from the competitive bidding requirements of this article; however, a formal written
15	contract, approved by the commission, shall be required for all such contracts in excess of twenty-
16	five thousand (\$25,000.00) dollars; and
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18	WHEREAS, over the past six years, the services of Mr. Armando Rojas were utilized to
19	support various systems and functions across City Departments; including support for the
20	implementation of new systems, computer-related issues, streamlining computer equipment
21	implementation, public safety software deployment, as well as the architecting and execution of
22	new facility networks and security; and
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24	WHEREAS, in an effort to provide continuity in the Department, temporary consulting
25	services have been sought from Mr. Rojas in the current fiscal year, and while the Department is
26	re-organized, re-structured, and properly staffed. Starting October 1, 2020, Mr. Rojas worked
27	through K-Force Government Solutions, Inc., for 242 hours, totaling an amount of \$24,200 dollars,
28	up to November 16, 2020. On November 18, 2020, the City Commission, via Resolution No. 2020-
29	104, authorized the utilization of GSA contracts including K-Force Government Solutions, Inc.
30	with an effective date of October 1, 2020, which would authorize the services rendered by Mr.
31	Rojas under the City Manager's delegated authority; and
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33	WHEREAS, City administration has developed a transition plan wherein Mr. Rojas will
34	build a knowledge repository, implement a documentation process, and train staff on configuration
35	and management of critical infrastructure and system-wide technology over the course of 6 to 9
36	months; and

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38	WHERES, the City Manager's purchasing authority for professional services is \$25,000.
39	For this transition to be successful, the cost of consulting services moving forward by Mr. Rojas
40	is \$120,000 through APX Technology Consulting, LLC., and \$25,000 through K-Force
41	Government Solutions, Inc. for the prior period, for a maximum of \$145,000 in Fiscal Year
42	2020/2021; and
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44	WHEREAS Mr. Rojas services are unique in the sense that only he possesses knowledge
45	of critical city infrastructure which could not be obtained from another source at this time; and
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47	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that engaging the services
48	of APX Technology Consulting is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach.
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50	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
51	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
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53	SECTION 1. City Manager's Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby
54	authorize the City Manager to execute an Agreement with APX Technology Consulting in an
55	amount not to exceed One Hundred and Twenty Thousand (\$120,000.00) dollars, ratify the use
56	of K-Force Government Solutions, Inc for an amount not to exceed twenty five thousand (\$25,000)
57	for the period referenced above, and authorize the City Manager to execute all necessary
58	documents to effectuate the engagement of said services.
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60	SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
61	passage and adoption.
