A RESOLUTION OF THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY APPROVING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH AND THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY AGENCY RELATING TO THE ADMINISTRATION BY THE HBCRA OF THE CITY'S SHUTTER/IMPACT GLASS AND SENIOR MINIGRANT PROGRAMS FOR RESIDENTS WHO RESIDE OUTSIDE THE CRA BOUNDARIES; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the mission of the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency ("HBCRA") is to promote economic development and enhance the quality of life by eliminating and preventing blighted conditions through residential rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, The HBCRA previously administered the City's residential program for assisting residents with the installation of shutters or impact glass until fiscal year 2019, when the City stopped funding the residential program; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2023, the City Commission allocated One Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$100,000.00) to fund two (2) residential programs consisting of a shutter/impact glass program and a senior mini-grant program for residents who reside outside the Community Redevelopment Area (the "CRA") boundaries; and

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2023, the City Commission allocated One Hundred Seventy Seven Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$177,000.00) as part of the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 adopted budget to fund two (2) residential programs consisting of a shutter/impact glass program and a senior mini-grant program for residents who reside outside the CRA boundaries; and

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2024, the City Commission allocated Two Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$200,000.00) as part of the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 adopted budget to fund two (2) residential programs consisting of a shutter/impact glass program and a senior mini-grant program for residents who reside outside the CRA boundaries; and

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2025, the City Commission allocated Two Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$200,000.00) as part of the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 adopted budget to fund two (2) residential programs consisting of a shutter/impact glass program and a senior mini-grant program for residents who reside outside the CRA boundaries; and

WHEREAS, HBCRA Staff is currently managing a shutter/impact window glass program and a senior mini-grant program for residents residing within the CRA boundaries and, as such, HBCRA Staff is uniquely qualified to manage the City's programs since HBCRA Staff

46 WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to approve the Interlocal 47 Agreement relating to the administration by the HBCRA of the City's shutter/impact glass and 48 49 senior mini-grant programs for residents who reside outside the CRA boundaries. 50 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS 51 52 OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY: 53 54 Section 1. Recitals. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and 55 incorporated into this Resolution. 56 57 Section 2. Approval of Interlocal Agreement. The Board of Directors of the HBCRA hereby approves the Interlocal Agreement relating to the administration by the HBCRA for Fiscal 58 Year 2025-2026 of the City's shutter/impact glass and senior mini-grant programs for residents 59 who reside outside the CRA boundaries in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" 60 61 and by this reference made a part hereof together with such non-material changes as may be requested by the City and acceptable to the Executive Director and approved as to form and 62 legality by the HBCRA Attorney. 63 Section 3. Execution of Interlocal Agreement. The Executive Director is hereby 64 authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement. 65 Section 4. Implementation of Interlocal Agreement. The Executive Director is hereby 66 67 authorized to take all steps necessary and appropriate to implement the terms and conditions of 68 the Interlocal Agreement 69 Section 5. Effective Date.
