24	expen	ditures, appropriations and other miscellaneous adjustments reflected herein; and	
25		WHEREAS, this proposed budget amendment is still within the allotted time	
26	pursuant to Florida Statutes; and		
27 28		WHEREAS, the City Administration proposes that the FY 2024-2025 adopted	
29	budge	t be amended to include the following transactions:	
30 31 32 33	1.	Reversal of Legal Judgement Fund – \$4,300,000. This expenditure will be funded as a transfer from General Liability Fund reserves;	
34 35 36	2.	International City Manager Association Fellow Program – \$25,857. This expenditure will be funded by General Fund reserves;	
37 38 39 40	3.	Additional Police Officers – \$440,587. This expenditure will be funded by General Fund reserves;	

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41 42 43	4.	Citywide Records Modernization and Compliance Initiative – \$350,921. This expenditure will be funded by a transfer from the General Fund reserves;

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84 85	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and
86	incorporated herein.

88	SECTION 2. Adoption of Budget Amendment. The Mayor and City
89	Commission hereby adopt the budget amendment to the FY 2024-2025 adopted budget
90	as set forth in Attachments A of this ordinance.
91 92	SECTION 3. Conflict. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, or parts
93	of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of the conflict.

95	SECTION 4. Severability. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by
96	a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of
97	this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part that is declared to be
98	invalid.

100	SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon
101	adoption.
