A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE FEDERAL DISASTER ASSISTANCE NONPROFIT FAIRNESS ACT OF 2017 CURRENTLY BEING CONSIDERED BY THE SENATE TO MAKE SYNAGOGUES AND OTHER PLACES OF WORSHIP ELIGIBLE FOR DISASTER RELIEF; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Staff Summary:

Background:

Vice Mayor London requested staff bring forward an item for Commission consideration in support of the Federal Disaster Assistance Non-Profit Fairness Act of 2017 currently being considered by the Senate. The Federal Disaster Assistance Nonprofit Fairness Act of 2017 was passed last week in the U.S. House of Representatives and is now pending in the Senate, the bill amends the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to grant houses of worship access to federal disaster relief funding. The measure would provide significant assistance to synagogues and churches in areas affected by natural disasters.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Article V, Section 5.01 of the City of Hallandale Beach Charter, a Resolution adopted by the Commission is an expression of the Commission on matters of official concern and opinion.

Proposed Action:
