16	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-9 of the City of Hallandale Beach ("City")
17	Code, the City Manager shall have the authority to join with other units of government in
18	cooperative purchasing plans or to purchase pursuant to formal written contracts or
19	competitive bids of other governmental units, when the best interests of the City would be
20	served, subject to the requirement that purchases in excess of \$50,000 require City
21	Commission approval; and

23	WHEREAS, the City participates in the Southeast Florida Governmental
24	Purchasing Cooperative ("Co-op") which is comprised of governmental entities to provide
25	cost savings and cost avoidances to member entities by utilizing the buying power of
26	combined requirements for common basic items; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, the City of Tamarac, acting as lead agency for the Co-op awarded Bid
29	#17-22B for the purchase of quicklime to Lhoist North America of Alabama, LLC through
30	Resolution R-2017-87 for a term of three (3) years, beginning November 1, 2017 with up
31	to three (3) one (1) year renewals to be exercised based upon satisfactory performance
32	("Co-op contract"); and
33	
34	WHEREAS, on October 4, 2017, the City Commission adopted Resolution No.
35	2017-115 for the purchase of quicklime utilizing the Co-op contract; and
36	
37	WHEREAS, the City Administration projects that the expenditure for quicklime for
38	Fiscal Year 2018-2019 will be two hundred fifty six thousand five hundred dollars
39	(\$256,500); and

41	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best
42	interest of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to continue to utilize the Co-op
43	contract to purchase quicklime for water treatment plant operations for Fiscal Year 2018-

47 48	SECTION 1. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission
49	hereby authorize the City Manager to purchase quicklime utilizing the Southeast Florida
50	Governmental Purchasing Cooperative contract pursuant to Bid #17-22B between the City
51	of Tamarac and Lhoist North America of Alabama, LLC for an amount not to exceed two
52	hundred fifty six thousand five hundred dollars (\$256,500) for fiscal year FY 2018-2019.
53	The City Manager is authorized to take necessary actions to implement the project.

55	SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
56	its passage and adoption.
