WHEREAS, on September 16, 2020, City Commission approved Resolution No. 2020-079, which authorized the City's piggyback of the Florida Municipal Power Agency (FMPA) agreement with ENCO Utility Services, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the FMPA agreement with ENCO Utility Services, LLC is for an initial period of five (5) years effective on the contract execution date of August 10, 2018 through August 2023; and
