18	2019-069, which authorized the City's piggyback of the Florida Municipal Power Agency
19	(FMPA) agreement with ENCO Utility Services, LLC; and
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21	WHEREAS, on September 16, 2020, City Commission approved Resolution No.
22	2020-079, which authorized the City's piggyback of the Florida Municipal Power Agency
23	(FMPA) agreement with ENCO Utility Services, LLC; and
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25	WHEREAS, on December 15, 2021, City Commission approved Resolution No.
26	2021-022, which authorized the City's piggyback of the Florida Municipal Power Agency
27	(FMPA) agreement with ENCO Utility Services, LLC; and
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29	WHEREAS, the FMPA agreement with ENCO Utility Services, LLC is for an initial
30	period of five (5) years effective on the contract execution date of August 10, 2018 through
31	August 2023; and
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33	WHEREAS, the City has reviewed various contracts for utility billing
34	printing/mailing services and find that piggybacking off the FMPA contract with ENCO
35	Utility Services is most cost effective for the City; and

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 WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the City Commission authorize the City Manager to piggyback the Florida Municipal Power Agency contract with ENCO Utility Services, LLC for utility billing, printing/mailing services for an amount as provided for in Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand, One Hundred Dollars (\$126,100); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach and its residents to piggyback the Florida Municipal Power Agency contract with ENCO Utility Services, LLC for an amount as provided for in Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand, One Hundred Dollars (\$126,100).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to utilize of the Florida Municipal Power Agency's contract with ENCO Utility Services, LLC for utility billing, printing/mailing services for an amount as provided for in Fiscal Year 2022-2023 budget not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand, One Hundred Dollars (\$126,100). The City Manager is authorized to execute all related documents to effectuate the project.

**SECTION 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
