4 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
5 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING
6 THE PIGGY-BACKING OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF
7 STATE PROCUREMENT OFFICIALS VALUEPOINT AGREEMENT
8 FOR OPENGOV BUDGETING SOFTWARE IN AN AMOUNT NOT
9 TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THIRTY SEVEN THOUSAND
10 FOUR HUNDRED FORTY ONE (\$137,441) DOLLARS; AND
11 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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14 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 23-8(6) Bids and Contracts from other entities, the City
15 Manager is authorized to procure all supplies, materials, equipment and services pursuant to
16 competitive bids and formal contracts of other governmental units when the best interests of the
17 City would be served, subject to the requirement that any purchase in excess of \$50,000.00
18 requires City Commission approval; and
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20 **WHEREAS**, staff seeks City Commission approval to purchase the OpenGov budgeting
21 software solution utilizing the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO)
22 ValuePoint Agreement No. AR2472, Alternative Contract Source Number 43230000-NASPO-16-
23 ACS in an amount not to exceed one hundred thirty seven thousand four hundred and forty one
24 dollars (\$137,441); and
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26 **WHEREAS**, on October 29, 2020, the City and Broward County entered into a CARES
27 Subaward Agreement pursuant to which the County will subaward to the City a portion of the
28 funds the County received from the CARES Act. Funding supports various projects that facilitate
29 compliance with safety protocols for remote collaboration and productivity during the COVID-19
30 Pandemic. The purchase of productivity software and technology is included as a funded project
31 of the Subaward Agreement; and
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33 **WHEREAS**, OpenGov is a cloud based ERP software for cities, counties, and state
34 agencies, built for the unique budgeting, financial management, and citizen services needs of the
35 public sector. The OpenGov solution enables organizations to plan more strategically and
36 collaboratively, streamline mission-critical processes, and communicate with stakeholders more
37 transparently. To that end it will facilitate compliance with safety protocols for remote
38 collaboration and productivity during the COVID-19 Pandemic; and
