SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING UTILIZATION OF THE ST. JOHNS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT BID #2022-16 AGREEMENT WITH BLISS PRODUCTS AND SERVICES INC. TO PROVIDE RESURFACING OF THE PLAYGROUND AT OB JOHNSON PARK FOR A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED, THIRTY-EIGHT THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE DOLLARS (\$138,381); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

The purpose of the agenda item is to request the City Commission approval of the attached resolution authorizing the City Manager to procure playground surfacing from Bliss Products and Services Inc utilizing St. Johns County School District Bid #2022-16 for a total amount not to exceed of \$138,381.

Background:

Parks amenities were inspected for replacement and placed on the Renewal and Replacement list. OB Johnson Park playground surface replacement was originally slated to be replaced in FY2027. The playground surface needs to be replaced in FY2026 due to the deteriorated condition which is considered a safety hazard. The playground is currently closed until the resurfacing is completed.

Current Situation:

The playground surface at OB Johnson Park needs replacement due to wear and tear and deterioration. Due to safety concerns, replacements are warranted as soon as possible.

Staff seeks to piggyback the agreement between St. Johns County School District (SJCSD) and Bliss Products and Services Inc. via contract number 2022-16. Under this agreement, staff will utilize funds in the amount of \$138,381, with a portion (\$33,381) coming from the Renewal and Replacement Fund and the remainder (\$105,000) from the Village of Bluesten Park Developer's Agreement. The initial term of the St. Johns County School District Bliss Products and Services Inc. contract was from July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023. On March 7, 2023, the first renewal period was exercised which provided a new expiration date of June 30, 2024. On March 25, 2024, the second renewal period was exercised and provided a new expiration date of June 30, 2025. On January 13, 2025, the third and final renewal period was exercised with a new expiration date of June 30, 2026.

Not all quoted items are priced out in the SJCSD contract; however, the department recommends contracting a single vendor for cohesion and efficacy of the project as it is not efficient to quote it and purchase from another source because this vendor will be performing the other aspects of the project. In addition, the vendor is extending additional savings far beyond the contracted rates.

The deterioration of the playground surfacing has the potential to be a safety hazard and needs to be rectified as soon as possible.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Code of Ordinances, in accordance with Procurement Code Section 23-5 Competitive procurement required; Procurement Mechanisms, (4) Piggybacking. Procuring goods or services from vendors who have been selected as a result of a competitive selection process by another governmental entity. The selection process utilized by the contracting entity must be substantially similar to the requirements of the City. The goods or services procured by the City must be procured pursuant to the original contract scope and terms. Furthermore, Section 23-9, Award, (e) The City Manager may award procurements within the delegated spending authority. All other procurements, except emergency procurements, require commission approval for award.

Cost Benefit:

Utilization of this contract will provide cost savings due to economies of scale. By utilizing this contract, the City can purchase the goods and services through a cooperative procurement process where all equipment, products, or services are priced at or below the supplier's proposal.
