

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 007**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, CREATING SECTION 2-108 "ACCESSIBILITY ADVISORY BOARD" IN CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION," ARTICLE III "BOARDS, COMMITTEES, DISTRICTS AND AUTHORITIES"; TO APPLY GENERAL ADVISORY BOARD PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, during the commission workshop meetings of February 13, 2017, March 13, 2017 and April 17, 2017 the City Commission reviewed the composition, powers and responsibilities of all City Advisory Boards and Committees; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission requested the creation of a new Accessibility Advisory Board to address the needs of seniors and disabled residents and make recommendations for improved access and inclusion of those residents; and

**WHEREAS**, in May 2018, the city Commission approved codification of general provisions applying to all advisory boards and to codify all advisory boards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission find that it is in the best interest of the residents of the City to create the Accessibility Advisory Board subject to the general rules applicable to all advisory boards and committees.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** Chapter 2 "Administration," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hallandale Beach, Florida, Division 2, "Advisory Boards and Committees" is amended to read as follows:

**ARTICLE III. - BOARDS, COMMITTEES, DISTRICTS AND AUTHORITIES**

33 **DIVISION 2. ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMITTEES**

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35 Sec. 2-108. – Accessibility Advisory Board. There is hereby created an Accessibility  
36 Advisory Board as an advisory board to the City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach to  
37 address the needs of seniors and disabled residents and make recommendations for improved  
38 access and inclusion of those residents.

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40 (a) The Board shall review, formulate, and coordinate information, suggestions,  
41 proposals, and plans; shall address complaints from the general public by  
42 identifying areas for collaboration and partnership for delivery of accessible  
43 facilities and services to citizens with disabilities; and make recommendations to  
44 the City Commission and/or City staff as needed.

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46 (b) The Board shall seek ways to provide more conveniently accessible facilities,  
47 public buildings, streets, sidewalks, and programs for the persons with disabilities  
48 in the City.

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50 (c) The Board may be consulted with in terms of prioritization of accessibility-related  
51 improvements to City facilities. Recommendations regarding priorities may  
52 address both the order in which facilities are modified and the importance of  
53 particular improvements to each respective facility.

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55 (d) The Board will provide input to the City Commission and Staff on concerns that  
56 affect the life and living conditions of persons with disabilities in Hallandale Beach,  
57 serve as advisors and resources for technical advice due to the complexity of  
58 concerns that arise when attempting to ensure the needs of citizens with  
59 disabilities are provided, and encourage providers with a focus on disability  
60 services and programs to participate in the efforts of the Board.

64           **SECTION 3. Conflict.** All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City  
65 of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent  
66 of such conflict.

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68           **SECTION 4. Severability.** Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a court  
69 of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a  
70 whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

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72           **SECTION 5. Codification.** It is the intention of the Mayor and City Commission that the  
73 provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect such intention  
74 the words "ordinance" or "section" may be changed to other appropriate words.

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76           **SECTION 6. Effective date.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
