15	WHEREAS, in 2023-24 the City of Hallandale Beach (the "City") instituted a
16	Residential Program for the area of the city outside the HBCRA boundaries to install hurricane
17	shutters or impact glass and added a Senior Mini-Grant program for seniors sixty years of
18	age and older. Due to their experience, the program was managed by the Hallandale Beach
19	Community Redevelopment Agency (the "HBCRA") ; and
20	WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the City Commission approve the implementation
21	and funding of the program in FY 24-25 for \$200,000, plus salary costs for HBCRA employees
22	managing the program, estimated at \$100,000 for the fiscal year; and
23	WHEREAS, the City Commission desires approve the implementation of the grant
24	programs and to approve the Interlocal Agreement relating to the programs between the City
25	and the HBCRA, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference
26	made a part hereof.
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
28	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
