THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, DECLARING A UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCE PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 23, SECTION 8 (5), EXCEPTION TO BID REQUIREMENTS, OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES: **AUTHORIZING** THE CITY MANAGER TO AGREEMENTS FOR ONLINE PAYMENT SOLUTIONS WITH PAYMENTUS CORPORATION FOR MERCHANT SERVICES AND BILL PAYMENT OPTIONS, BANK UP CORPORATION FOR LOCKBOX SERVICES, ADCOMP SYSTEMS GROUP FOR KIOSK SERVICES AND TYLER MUNIS FOR INTERACTIVE VOICE RESPONSE (IVR) GATEWAY FOR AMOUNTS AS **BUDGETED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

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WHEREAS, the Utility Billing (UB) division has identified numerous challenges with Tyler/Munis' online payment solutions, Citizen Service (CSS) and utility billing mail-in/ check payments; and

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WHERESAS, in order to address these challenges and resolve the issues, the UB division has taken a systematic approach to provide a comprehensive solution, which includes online payment solutions provider, merchant services, offering multiple bill pay channels on a single integrated reporting platform and providing lockbox services which fully integrates with the recommended vendor Paymentus Corporation; and

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30 31 WHEREAS, staff has performed a thorough analysis and it has been determined that contracting with Paymentus Corporation and the ancillary vendors, Bank Up Corporation, AdComp Systems and Tyler Munis, will provide the UB division with an all-inclusive solution; and

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WHEREAS, Paymentus Corporation is unique in that it is the only Tyler/Munis approved credit card processor that can also provide an online payment solution, which the City seeks to implement. Consequently, Paymentus is the only company that can resolve issues encountered by the UB Division. Paymentus' services will replace both Tyler/Munis CSS for UB and the merchant service/gateway, Fist Data/Authorize.net.; and

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WHEREAS, Paymentus provides a unified payment solution. Paymentus also offers 24
hours, 7 days a week payment solution which includes: customer self-service portal, phone
payment system with outbound interactive voice response IVR, enterprise communication
manager (ECM), bill-pay app, and agent dashboard (i.e. payment tracking); and

WHEREAS, city staff equally recommends contracting with Paymentus and the ancillary vendors for an initial term of five (5) years with the option to renew for additional term(s) not to exceed a total of ten years. Bank Up Corporation would provide lockbox services for processing the City's mail-in/check payments inclusive of applying payments to customer's accounts and depositing payments into the City's bank account; AdComp Systems Group would provide Kiosk services, which fully integrates with Paymentus, as a result all transactions processed through Adcomp's kiosk will be processed through Paymentus; and Tyler/Munis- which will provide the Interactive Voice Response (IVR) gateway in order to integrate with Paymentus; and

 WHEREAS, the ancillary vendors are uniquely technical in that they there are the only vendors which are fully compatible and integrated with the Paymentus system for the identified function; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8 Exception to Bid Requirements, (5) Unique Circumstances, the City Commission may determine that there are unique circumstances to establish that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, City Administration recommends the City Commission determine there are unique circumstances and waive the competitive bidding requirements for the purchase of these services; and

 WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Commission have determined that it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager to execute agreements and/or related documents an initial term of 5 years for an online payment solution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Declaration of Unique Circumstance. The Mayor and City Commission declare a Unique Circumstance pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 8 (5) of the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances due to unique compatibilities of software and other data solutions programs to the existing vendors and programs of the city for the provision of online payment solutions.

SECTION 3. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and the City Commission have determined that it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement and/or related documents for a total amount not to exceed Seventy-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Eight (\$77,248) dollars for FY 2020 with 1. Paymentus Corporation to procure merchant and bill payment services; 2. Bank-Up Corporation to procure lockbox services; 3. AdComp Systems Group to procure a kiosk and maintenance services and 4. Tyler Munis For Interactive Voice Response (IVR), and authorize the City Manager to contract with the ancillary vendors to wit: Bank-Up Corporation, AdComp Systems Group and Tyler Munis, for an initial term of five (5) years with the option to renew, at City Manager's discretion, for additional term(s) not to exceed a total of ten years. The City Manager is authorized to take all necessary action to implement the project.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
