RESOLUTION NO. 2017-

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,
CONDEMNING EXTREMISM, BIGOTRY AND HATE;
URGING OTHER MUNICIPALITIES TO ENDORSE AND
SUPPORT THE EFFORTS OF THE ANTI-DEFAMATION
LEAGUE AND UNITED STATES CONFERENCE OF
MAYORS TO CURTAIL SUCH IDEOLOGIES; AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach is home to people of diverse backgrounds, from communities of diverse beliefs and cultures, including immigrants and native-born citizens; and

WHEREAS, the cohesiveness and inclusiveness of our communities depend on our residents' willingness to treat one another equally and with respect in employment, housing, public accommodations, and other areas of public life; and

WHEREAS, hateful and intolerant acts against others are contrary to the values of acceptance, openness, and fellowship with those of all faiths, beliefs, cultures and backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, hate crimes, hate speech, and other acts of bigotry and extremism affect individual victims physically and emotionally and also impact their families, communities, and the entire group whose identity, culture, or beliefs were the motivation for hateful acts and rhetoric; and

WHEREAS, the Anti-Defamation League and the United States Conference of Mayors have launched an initiative to fight extremism and bigotry and promote justice and equality; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission denounce in the strongest terms the increase of hate speech, intimidations, violence, and hate crimes targeted against immigrants, refugees, people of diverse racial, ethnic, religious, and linguistic backgrounds, individuals with impairments, and those who are LGBTQ and supports efforts to fight these ideologies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That each of the above recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby condemn the increase of hate speech, intimidations, violence, and hate crimes targeted against immigrants, refugees, people of diverse racial, ethnic, religious, and linguistic backgrounds, individuals with impairments, and those who are LGBTQ and urge other municipalities to support the efforts of the Anti-Defamation League and the United States Conference of Mayors to fight these ideologies.

SECTION 3. The Mayor and City Commission direct the Clerk to cause a copy of this resolution to be forwarded to all appropriate parties.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
