**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY  
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE  
BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE INTERLOCAL  
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF  
HALLANDALE BEACH AND THE HALLANDALE  
BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY  
RELATING TO THE PROVISION OF COMMUNITY  
POLICING SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-  
2023; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (HBCRA) desires to enter into an agreement with the City of Hallandale Beach additional police services to create a drug and crime-free environment and to provide for the safety and protection of the property owners, business owners, residents, and patrons of businesses located within the Community Redevelopment Area ("CRA") all in compliance with the intent of Chapter 163, Part III, Florida Statutes regarding Community Policing Innovations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement between the City and the HBCRA will, among other things, provide funding by the HBCRA to the City for the continued support of the Quadrant Safety Board (QSB), Community Education Courses, the Strategic Intelligence Unit (SIU), and Grant Training; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission approve the Interlocal Agreement between the HBCRA and the City, attached as Exhibit A, for costs relating to Community Policing Innovations for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 in an amount Not to Exceed one million seven hundred sixteen thousand nine hundred and seventy one (\$1,716,971) dollars.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY  
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby approve an Interlocal Agreement between the HBCRA and the City, attached as Exhibit A, for costs relating to Community Policing Innovations for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 in an amount Not to Exceed one million seven hundred sixteen thousand nine hundred and seventy one (\$1,716,971) dollars, and authorize the City Manager to execute all relating documents.

**SECTION 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
