RESOLUTION NO. 2026 -**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING CONTINUED UTILIZATION OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, N.C.'S OMNIA PARTNERS CONTRACT WITH BIG TRUCK RENTAL, LLC FOR EQUIPMENT RENTALS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-27 RENTAL OF TRUCKS FOR A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF SEVEN HUNDRED, EIGHTY-FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$784,000); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Section 23-5 Competitive procurement required; procurement mechanisms, Subsection (4) Piggybacking, the City may procure goods or services from vendors who have been selected as a result of a competitive selection process by another governmental entity if the selection process utilized by the contracting entity was substantially similar to the requirements of the City, and the goods or services procured by the City are procured pursuant to the original contract scope and terms; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach Sanitation Division's commercial, multi-family, and residential solid waste collection services operate seven days and for the past several years has utilized the City of Charlotte, N.C.'s OMNIA PARTNERS contract #2019000319 with Big Truck Rental, LLC for Equipment Rentals and Related Products and Services for rental trucks as part of its sanitation fleet; and

WHEREAS, currently, the City-owned side-loader fleet includes two (2) 2017 models, two (2) 2020 models, and one (1) 2024 model purchased during the current fiscal year, and the City also rents two (2) side loaders, but one of the two City-owned (2) 2017 trucks is out of service and scheduled for replacement in FY2027, while the other has reached the end of its useful life and will be retired within the next year, and both of these 2017 trucks will be sold at public auction in either FY2026 or FY2027; and

38 **WHEREAS**, the City’s plan is to own four (4) and rent (2) side loaders for
39 operational purposes, and to rent four (4) front loader trucks to serve commercial
40 customers. Further, staff recommends authorization of an additional allowance of up
41 to \$30,000.00 for transportation delivery and repair costs that may be required as part
42 of the contract if a truck is swapped out or returned with substantial cosmetic damage;

44 **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission find it to
45 be in the public interest to authorize continued utilization of the City of Charlotte, N.C.’s
46 OMNIA PARTNERS contract #2019000319 with Big Truck Rental, LLC for Equipment
47 Rentals and Related Products and Services for fiscal year 2026-27 rental of trucks as
48 part of its sanitation fleet for a total not to exceed amount of Seven Hundred, Eighty-
49 Four Thousand Dollars (\$784,000), and authorize the City Manager to execute relating
50 documents.

58 Commission hereby authorize continued utilization of the City of Charlotte, N.C.’s
59 OMNIA PARTNERS contract #2019000319 with Big Truck Rental, LLC for Equipment
60 Rentals and Related Products and Services for fiscal year 2026-27 rental of trucks as
61 part of its sanitation fleet for a total not to exceed amount of Seven Hundred, Eighty-
62 Four Thousand Dollars (\$784,000), and authorize the City Manager to execute relating
63 documents.
