RESOLUTION NO. 2018-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR TEMPORARY DEBRIS MANAGEMENT SITES AND OTHER RELATED SERVICES WITH THE TERM STARTING UPON EXECUTION OF THE AGREEMENT AND ENDING ON NOVEMBER 30, 2022; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE PROJECT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **WHEREAS**, on February 27, 2018 the Broward County (“County”) Board of County
17 Commissioners approved an interlocal agreement (“ILA”) enabling municipalities to utilize the
18 County’s temporary debris management sites in the aftermath of a natural or man-made disaster;
19 and

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21 **WHEREAS**, the County requires that government entities execute the ILA by March 31,
22 2018 in order to utilize the County’s temporary debris management sites. The ILA becomes
23 effective upon execution and will terminate on November 30, 2022. Upon mutual written consent,
24 the ILA can be extended for two additional five-year terms; and

25
26 **WHEREAS**, the ILA states that each City shall be invoiced for the proportionate share of
27 the cost for the associated Debris Management Center staff time. This proportionate share will be
28 based upon the volume of debris delivered by or on behalf of the City to the temporary debris
29 management sites; and

30
31 **WHEREAS**, historically, in the event of a disaster, such as a hurricane, the City has used
32 Peter Bluesten Park as the only approved temporary debris management site. Peter Bluesten
33 Park is no longer available for this use because the Park is undergoing construction; and

34
35 **WHEREAS**, the City Administration recommends the City Commission authorize the City
36 Manager to execute the ILA with the County for temporary debris management sites and other
37 related services; and
