The firm of Craven Thompson & Associates, Inc. (CTA) is pleased to provide you with the following proposal for professional surveying, civil engineering, and landscape architectural design services through our Continuing Service Contract FY 2013-2014-006, for the above referenced project.

The project area is located within the Three Islands Neighborhood on Three Islands Boulevard to Atlantic Shores Boulevard. The project consists of traffic calming, accessible ramps and crosswalks, landscaping and lighting at guard houses, electronic speed feedback signs, bike lane markings, guard house painting and gate arm replacement. The improvements are based on the ADA Engineering Study "Three Islands Guardhouses and Traffic Calming Project Master Plan Report" dated May 10, 2016.

Our specific scope is as follows:

I. <u>SURVEYING SERVICES</u>

1.1 <u>Design Survey</u> (CTA Task No. 11290)

Prepare a design survey for design purposes within the city-owned Right-of-Way along Three Islands Boulevard from the Guard House north of Hallandale Beach Boulevard to the City limits, west on Atlantic Shores Boulevard from Three Islands Boulevard to the Guard House and on Parkview Drive from the bridge to the City Limits. The total length of survey is approximately 6,000 LF of roadway. The survey will meet current surveying requirements of the Board of Professional Surveyors and Mappers of the State of Florida, as defined in Chapter 5J-17.050-.052, Florida Administrative Code.

- The survey will include the recovery of sufficient existing boundary and/or right-of-way monumentation to determine the right-of-way lines needed in order to tie all visible improvements to.
- Locations of all <u>aboveground and visible improvements</u>, including all pavement, slabs, fences, signs, overhead wires, trees, and utility features, within the limits of the existing platted rights-of-way.

The firm of Craven Thompson & Associates, Inc. (CTA) is pleased to provide you with a proposal for additional services for professional civil engineering, landscape architectural design services for the above referenced project.

After submittal and presentation of the Conceptual Site Plan to City Transportation staff and the Community, additional items outside of the current contract were requested to be included in the final construction documents. In order to successfully complete the project and satisfy the needs and requests of the community, the following additional service items are proposed:

- The project limits will be revised and expanded to include the following: Atlantic Shores Blvd. from the Guardhouse on the west to Three Islands Boulevard on the east. Three Islands Boulevard from the City limit on the north to the Guardhouse on the south. Parkview Drive from Three Islands Boulevard east to the City limit. Leslie Drive from Parkview Drive south to the cul-de-sac.

- Geotechnical pavement core testing.
- Construction Administration Services & Project Certification
