21	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-9 of the City of Hallandale Beach ("City")
22	Code, the City Manager shall have the authority to join with other units of government in
23	cooperative purchasing plans or to purchase pursuant to formal written contracts or

25	served, subject to the requirement that purchases in excess of \$50,000 require City
26	Commission approval; and

29	(NIGP) Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Co-operative Group (SEFL), the City
30	is able to participate in and utilize competitively solicited contracts to obtain the best
31	goods/services and pricing available in the market.
32 33	WHEREAS, the City utilizes the NIGP SEFL Contract # 13-D-140F for the
34	procurement of temporary staffing services from the selected companies; and

36	WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends authorizing the City Manager to
37	execute all related documents to effectuate the purchases for temporary staffing services
38	for FY 17-18 through NIGP SEFL Contract #13-D-140F.
