WHEREAS, the mission of the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency
("HBCRA") is to promote economic development and enhance the quality of life by eliminating
and preventing slum and blighted conditions through the facilitation of community partnerships,
business growth, job creation, and neighborhood rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors previously approved a fully revamped array of Residential Program including the Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP), the Enhanced Paint Program (EPP) which was later renamed the Paint the Town Program (PTT), and the Senior Mini-Grant Program (SMGP); and

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29 WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, the City of Hallandale Beach executed a Declaration of Emergency in response to the deadly Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic that had begun to sweep 30 the globe; since the period surrounding the emergency declarations by National, State, County 31 and Local governments respectively, the virus has continued unabated, and the lives of those 32 33 internationally, nationally and locally have been severely impacted; thousands have died, stay at home orders, social distancing, self-isolation, and quarantine have become a way of life as cities 34 have struggled to cope with the effects of the pandemic, and cities have been forced to shut down 35 all non-essential businesses; and 36

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WHEREAS, the HBCRA understands that many families are facing tremendous amounts
of economic hardships due to the Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic; and

41 **WHEREAS,** the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to (i) approve certain 42 modifications to the NIP, PTT, and the SMGP as set forth in the Agenda Cover Memo (ii) authorize 43 the Executive Director to appropriate funds, as needed, from any of the other Residential 44 Programs to meet the greatest Residential Program demand, and (iii) authorize the Executive Director to make changes to the Residential Programs and applications (excluding or including eligibility) on an as-needed basis as market conditions allow, due to the fluidity of the current economic and market conditions, which are occurring due to the Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY:

53 Section 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and 54 incorporated into this Resolution. 55

56 Section 2. <u>Modifications to Residential Programs</u>. The modifications to the 57 Neighborhood Improvement Program (NIP), the Paint the Town Program (PTT), and the Senior 58 Mini-Grant Program (SMGP) as set forth in the Agenda Cover Memo are hereby approved. 59

60 Section 3. <u>Authorization of Executive Director to Appropriate Funds</u>. The Executive 61 Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds, as needed, from any of the other Residential 62 Programs to meet the greatest Residential Program demand.

63 Section 4. <u>Authorization of Executive Director to Make Changes to the Residential</u> 64 <u>Programs</u>. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to make changes to the Residential 65 Programs and applications (excluding or including eligibility) on an as-needed basis as market 66 conditions allow, due to the fluidity of the current economic and market conditions, which are 67 occurring due to the Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic.

68 Section 5. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
