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4 5 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CENTRAL SQUARE LLC, A SOLE SOURCE VENDOR, FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF THE CITY'S FALSE ALARM PROGRAM FOR AN ANNUAL COST OF FORTY THOUSAND (\$40,000) DOLLARS FOR A TERM OF FIVE (5) YEARS, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$200,000) DOLLARS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE PURCHASE; AMENDING THE FEE SCHEDULE BOOKLET TO INCLUDE FEES ASSOCIATED WITH FALSE ALARM
15 16	PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
17	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-8, (3) Noncompetitive supplies.
18	Noncompetitive supplies, available only from one source, such as unique, patented or
19	franchised supplies, are exempt. The city manager is authorized to purchase and contract
20	for noncompetitive supplies in excess of \$50,000.00, provided authorized funds are
21	available in the annual budget and records of purchases exceeding \$50,000.00 are
22	available for review in the procurement department; and
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24	WHEREAS, currently staff is utilizing an antiquated computer data based of alarm
25	registrations for alarm billing; and
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27	WHEREAS, utilizing data obtained from the existing Records Management
28	Software (RMS) system, each registered alarm is billed at the end of the year based on
29	the number of alarms from the previous year; and
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31	WHEREAS, this established system does not allow for notification of false alarms
32	as they occur, and the residents and commercial businesses are often unaware of having
33	experienced a false alarm; and
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35	WHEREAS, the current process of alarm billing is labor intensive as to records
36	management and as to increased false alarm response by first responders; and
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WHEREAS, upon adoption of the newly enacted Chapter 7 Alarm Systems and False Alarm code of ordinances, adopted changes which include updated definitions, registration, reporting of responses and violations, proposed annual alarm registration and violation fees will enable the City's False Alarm Program to meet the ever-growing needs of the residents and businesses: and

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WHEREAS, through an online portal provided by CryWolf, there is an added
benefit of minimizing Staff requirements of managing and registering current alarm needs;
and

WHEEREAS, Central Square LLC currently provides RMS for the police
department. CryWolf, a Central Square platform, is a turnkey solution for management of
false alarm registration and billing that seamlessly integrates with the City's existing RMS
systems. Providing this service to residents, CryWolf allows for online registration, up to
date billing and notice of violations; and

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53 WHEREAS, the agreement with Central Square LLC will allow for the management 54 of False Alarm via a revenue sharing agreement with 80% share to the City and 20% to 55 Central Square, LLC, where the vendor manages and bills for the program and remits 56 remaining revenue to the City; and

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58 WHEREAS, the City Clerk has prepared a comprehensive booklet containing fees
59 and charges to be effective for the 2021-22 budget year; and

61 **WHEREAS**, service, user charges and fees, are set and amended by Resolution; 62 and

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64 **WHEREAS**, the City Commission has recently reenacted Chapter 7 Article III 65 Alarm Systems and False Alarms; and

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67 WHEREAS, the reenactment of Chapter 7 Article III Alarm Systems and False 68 Alarms further establishes fees for false alarms and appeals thereto; and

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WHEREAS, the implementation of these regulations necessitates amendment of
the fee schedule booklet to include penalty fees for false alarms and appeal fees.

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WHEREAS, staff recommends approval of an agreement with Central Square
LLC, a sole source vendor, for the management of the City's False Alarm program for an
annual cost of Forty Thousand (\$40,000) dollars for a term of five (5) years, for a total
amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand (\$200,000) dollars.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

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<u>SECTION 1.</u> The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

84 **SECTION 2.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City 85 Manager to enter into an agreement with Central Square LLC, a sole source vendor, for 86 the management of the City's False Alarm Program for an annual cost of Forty Thousand 87 (\$40,000) dollars for a term of five (5) years, for a total amount not to exceed Two Hundred 88 Thousand (\$200,000) dollars. Further authorizing the City Manager to execute all related 89 documents to effectuate the purchase.

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91 **SECTION 3.** The "Schedule of Fees and Charges" dated September 27, 2021 92 (Resolution #2021-106), which is on file with the City Clerk, is hereby amended to include 93 the fees and charges reflected in Exhibit "A" as the schedule of the fees and charges 94 applicable in the City of Hallandale Beach for all charges and services rendered by the 95 City, on or after October 1, 2021.

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97 <u>SECTION 4.</u> City Manager is authorized to promulgate and publish such fees and 98 charges and shall insure the proper collection and accounting of all monies arising 99 therefrom. In the event of doubt or ambiguity, the City Manager is authorized to determine 100 the appropriate fee.

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102	SECTION 5. City Manager is authorized to revise the appropriate fee(s) when
103	additional fees or charges are required by Broward county of the Florida State Legislature.
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105	SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
106	its passage and adoption.
