Evening CM, just a quick update on a few pressing things the team is responding to around the city.

Three Islands Blvd.-Sewer Lateral Line Collapse (DeSoto Condo)-The team has it exposed and are repairing the line, they should be done within a couple of hours. One lane of traffic is blocked, no loss of service to any one except the one building while the repair is made.

72-inch Stormwater Line at Gulfstream- The existing line is under repair now and should be done by end of the week. The design for the new one is coming forward for commission approval at an upcoming meeting. FYI, we are in communication and working with the engineering team at Gulfstream Park.

Multiple Small Water Service Leaks- this occurred and was responded to by the team over the past two days.

We continue to work towards the completion and restoration of services to all residents as quickly and safely as possible.
