23	WHEREAS, the HBCRA seeks to acquire certain real property for redevelopment and

39	(a) An aggrieved party may, by written application submitted to the city, manager request				
40	a mitigation of fines <u>and liens</u> . Such application shall set forth such fact and				
41	circumstances in favor of the application as the petitioner shall deem appropriate, as				
42	well as the amount, if any, offered in such compromise or settlement. A copy of such				
43	application shall be served on the city attorney at the time the original is filed. The city				
44	manager <u>, or his designee,</u> shall consider such application, sworn testimony and				
45	information or documents submitted by either party and, after due deliberation, the city				
46	manager <u>, or his designee,</u> shall have the right, duty, power, authority and jurisdiction				
47	to make decision to mitigate a fine in accordance with policies adopted by the city				
48	commission by resolution.				
49	(b) The city manager shall have the right, duty, power authority and jurisdiction to mitigate				
50	or release fines or liens encumbering property acquired by the City or any dependent				
51	special district of the City when such property is acquired for a public purpose,				
52	including, but not limited to, community redevelopment purposes.

54	SECTION 3. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City				
55	of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the

59	the provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect such
