Management and Development, Inc., and West Construction, Inc However, all but West					
Construction were disqualified as either non-responsive or not responsible pursuant to the					
City's Procurement Code; and					
WHEREAS, West Construction, Inc. was the lowest responsible and responsive					
bid at two million nine hundred seventy-one thousand five hundred and thirty seven dollars					
(\$2,971,537); and					

WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends that the City Commission award Bid # FY 2017-2018-003, Ingalls Park Construction to the lowest responsive responsible bidder, West Construction, Inc. in an amount not to exceed two million nine hundred seventy-one thousand five hundred and thirty seven dollars (\$2,971,537), and to authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement to effectuate the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with West Construction, Inc. for Ingalls Park Construction Bid # FY 2017-2018-003, in an amount not to exceed two million nine hundred seventy-one thousand five hundred and thirty seven dollars (\$2,971,537). The City Manager is further authorized to negotiate and execute all related documents to effectuate this project.
