12	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach has a large Jewish-American and Israeli-
13	American community residing in the City who have been affected by the unprovoked Hamas
14	terror on the State of Israel. The City Commission stands in solidarity with the Jewish
15	community, many of whom originate from European countries and have significant ties to
16	Europe; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, numerous news reports have described the rise in anti-Semitic acts,
19	including, but not limited to, the hunting of Jews that took place on the streets of Amsterdam
20	recently; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, the City Commission has taken action to fight antisemitism, including
23	adopting the definition of anti-Semitism drafted with the assistance of the American Jewish
24	Committee (AJC) and adopted by the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance, so that
25	the City Police Department should consider potential anti-Semitic motivation for criminal
26	offenses, in order to ensure the safety and well-being of its Jewish community; and
27 28	WHEREAS, the AJC, the global advocacy organization for the Jewish people, has
28 29	called for immediate action from European government ministers in response to surging and
29 30	increasingly violent antisemitism on the continent; and
30	increasingly volent antisemitism on the continent, and
32	WHEREAS, the AJC has called for emergency measures implementing new
33	enforcement, protection and justice-related actions in the fight against antisemitism,
34	including: creating internal monitoring and enforcement mechanisms to implement national
35	action plans; protecting Jewish communities by getting ahead of threats and establishing

intergovernmental taskforces; and, adopting a zero tolerance policy for antisemitic acts to
include full prosecution of hate crimes with clear penalties; and

WHEREAS, the proposals of the AJC are tangible steps that can be taken bygovernments that are truly committed to countering antisemitism; and

42 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission find that it is in the best interest of the 43 residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to support the calls of the AJC for European 44 governments, and, in fact, all governments, to recognize the existential threat facing the 45 Jewish community and to take tangible steps to protect these communities from the rise of 46 hate crimes and antisemitic acts.
