3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE A1A BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND AFFIRMING THE CITY'S INTENT TO FUND ALL COSTS FOR ITS DESIGN, INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE COMMUNITY AESTHETIC FEATURE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) FOR THE A1A BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
16	WHEREAS, the roadway and bridge located at the intersection of A1A and Eas
17	Hallandale Beach Boulevard is one of the most heavily trafficked routes in the City of
18	Hallandale Beach ("City"), utilized by residents and tourists to commute home and to visi
19	the City's beaches; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, a routine inspection of the A1A Bridge performed by the City's Public
22	Works Department on January 9, 2017 identified discoloration and deterioration of the
23	existing paint and coating on the bridge. After multiple attempts to pressure wash the
24 25	bridge, the City decided it would be in the best interest to repaint the A1A bridge; and
26	WHEREAS, the improvements proposed within the Florida Department of
27	Transportation ("FDOT") right-of-way include painting the A1A Bridge at Hallandale Beach
28	Boulevard, as depicted in Exhibit "A" within the boundaries of the project as depicted in
29	Exhibit "B", hereinafter known as the A1A Bridge Improvement Project. These
30	improvements do not include the FDOT Mechanically Stabilized Earth walls located on the
31	west side of the A1A Bridge and the FDOT Steel Bridge Repair Project; and
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33	WHEREAS, the FDOT Maintenance Division met with City staff on October 9
34	2017 and consented to the City advancing the A1A Bridge Improvement Project; and
35	
36	WHEREAS, as part of the approval process, FDOT requires the City to pass a
37	resolution stating that it approves the project and agrees to fund all costs for its design
38	installation, and maintenance; and

40	WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and its residents for the Mayor and
41	City Commission to approve of the A1A Bridge Improvement Project, and to authorize the
42	City Manager to execute a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement with FDOT allowing
43	the City to complete the A1A Bridge Improvement Project in the FDOT right-of-way.
44	
45	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
46	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
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48	SECTION 1. Approval of A1A Bridge Improvement Project. The Mayor and
49	City Commission hereby approve of the A1A Bridge Improvement Project, and affirm the
50	City's intent to fund the cost of its design, installation, and maintenance.
51	
52	SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission
53	hereby authorize the City Manager to execute a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement
54	with FDOT for the A1A Bridge Improvement Project, and to execute the necessary
55	documents to implement the project.

57	<b>SECTION 3. Effective Date.</b> This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
58	its passage and adoption.
