17 18	WHEREAS, wastewater is collected throughout the City and pumped by wastewater lift
19	stations to the City of Hollywood's sanitary sewer system through four (4) separate metered
20	connections; and
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22	WHEREAS, fifteen (15) lift stations are owned, operated, and maintained by the City, and
23	a few small privately owned lift stations that pump into the City's transmission system, including
24	Lift Station 16 on Ocean Drive, a lift station located at Gulfstream Park, a lift station located at
25	CVS Pharmacy, and a lift station located at Beachwalk Resort; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, in addition to the lift stations, the City owns and maintains a network of
28	approximately eleven (11) miles of force mains, fifty seven (57) miles of gravity sewer, and nearly
29	one thousand two hundred (1,200) manholes; and
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31	WHEREAS, recently, the City received a number of applications for major developments
32	to be located within the existing wastewater serves area; and
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34	WHEREAS, these major developments will generate additional wastewater flows that
35	must be accommodated within the City's system; and
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existing wastewater transmission system hydraulic model to determine their impacts; and

WHEREAS, flow projections from these developments were incorporated into the City's

WHEREAS, due to the fact that some of the proposed major developments that will impact Lift Station 8 are entering the construction, permitting or design phase, staff is recommending moving forward with the complete replacement of Lift Station 8 in order to upgrade its wastewater flow capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, to accomplish the replacement of Lift Station 8, staff is recommending a design-build process as a project delivery method; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration requests the Mayor and City Commission authorize the City Manager to issue a work authorization to Craven Thompson & Associates to provide all items included in Exhibit "3" (Proposal No. 2016-S04.364) in accordance with RFP #FY2013-2014-006, Continuing Services, for one hundred twenty seven thousand eight hundred eighty five (\$127,885.00) dollars, plus an additional fifteen (15%) percent contingency, as may be needed for assistance during the construction phase; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to authorize the City Manager to issue a work authorization to Craven Thompson & Associates to provide all items included in Exhibit "3" (Proposal No. 2016-S04.364) in accordance with RFP #FY2013-2014-006, Continuing Services, for one hundred twenty seven thousand eight hundred eighty five (\$127,885.00) dollars, plus an additional fifteen (15%) percent contingency, as may be needed for assistance during the construction phase.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> <u>City Manager's Authorization.</u> The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to issue a work authorization to Craven Thompson & Associates to provide all items included in Exhibit "3" (Proposal No. 2016-S04.364) in accordance with RFP #FY2013-2014-006, Continuing Services, for one hundred twenty seven thousand eight hundred eighty five (\$127,885.00) dollars, plus an additional fifteen (15%) percent contingency, as may be needed for assistance during the construction phase. Further authorizing the City Manager to
