2 RESOLUTION NO. 2022 –  
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4 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF  
5 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING  
6 THE EXPANSION OF GUNSHOT DETECTION SERVICES AS  
7 PROVIDED BY SHOTSPOTTER, INC. FOR AN EXPANDED  
8 AREA OF APPROXIMATELY 2.18 SQUARE MILES FOR AN  
9 AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FORTY-NINE THOUSAND FIVE  
10 HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$49,500); AND PROVIDING AN  
11 EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, all purchases of and contracts for equipment,  
15 supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000 must be  
16 approved by the City Commission, subject to stated exceptions; and  
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18 WHEREAS, in 2020 the City of Hallandale Beach experienced an increase in  
19 incidents of violent crime. There were nine (9) homicides and close to fifty (50) shooting incidents.  
20 As a result, the Hallandale Beach Police Department (HBPD) began the process of deploying  
21 numerous initiatives to include the hiring of an individual crime analyst, purchasing crime  
22 intelligence and data software, fully staffing the Strategic Intelligence Unit and Investigative  
23 Service Division, installing License Plate Reader Technology throughout the City, and developing  
24 an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) also known as Drone Unit; and  
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26 WHEREAS, on August 4, 2021, the City Commission approved Resolution 2021-078,  
27 which approved utilizing Law Enforcement Trust Funds through Broward Sheriff's Office to  
28 purchase deploy gunshot detection services provided by Shotspotter, Inc., a sole source vendor;  
29 and  
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31 WHEREAS, Resolution 2021-078 covers the area between Interstate-95 to Federal  
32 Highway and from Pembroke Road to West Hallandale Beach Boulevard and has been procured  
33 through the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) utilizing Equitable Sharing Funds due to the City; and  
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35 WHEREAS, HBPD seeks City Commission approval to procure additional Shotspotter  
36 Inc. gunshot detection services to expeditiously alert officers of gunshots within the proposed  
37 expanded coverage area which includes East of I-95 to Federal Highway and Hallandale Beach  
38 Boulevard to County Line Road, for a total expanded area of approximately 2.18 square miles.

39           **WHEREAS**, the expansion area will be covered under an agreement between the City and  
40 Shotspotter and will be funded by the General Fund in the amount of forty-nine thousand five  
41 hundred (\$49,500) dollars. The total annual cost of service for both areas is approximately  
42 ninety-nine thousand (\$99,000) dollars; and  
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44           **WHEREAS**, this expanded gunshot detection service area will enable HBPD to rapidly  
45 and precisely respond to incidents of gunfire, improve evidence recovery, and proactively impact  
46 gun violence. The system will aid detectives by providing more evidence and insight into an  
47 incident of crime and provide vital information regarding criminal activity within an area of concern.  
48 Finally, the system will also aid supervisors to better deploy their resources and develop strategies  
49 to combat violence crime; and  
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51           **WHEREAS**, staff recommends City Commission authorization to expand gunshot  
52 detection services as provided by Shotspotter, Inc. for an expanded area of approximately 2.18  
53 square miles for an amount not to exceed Forty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred dollars (\$49,500).  
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55           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**  
56 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**  
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58           **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.  
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60           **SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby  
61 authorize the approval to expand gunshot detection services as provided by Shotspotter, Inc. for  
62 an expanded area of approximately 2.18 square miles for an amount not to exceed Forty-Nine  
63 Thousand Five Hundred dollars (\$49,500) and authorize the City Manager to execute all related  
64 documents to effectuate the purchase.  
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66           **SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its  
67 passage and adoption.
